3	Brief Description of Activity	“Bharat Ke Sitare” is an engaging and interactive activity aimed at creating awareness about the lives and contributions of famous personalities from different Indian states. Participants will bring to life the inspiring stories of India’s legendary figures. The activity is designed to be both educational and entertaining, fostering a sense of national pride and unity among students.
4	Topics/Themes	<p>The central theme of the event is “ भारत के सितारे Stars of India ” — a celebration of iconic Indian personalities from across the country. The participants will explore and present the lives, struggles, and achievements of individuals who have made significant contributions in various domains. The sub-themes are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Freedom Fighters: e.g., Rani Lakshmi Bai, Subhas Chandra Bose, Bhagat Singh• Scientists and Innovators: e.g., Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam, C.V. Raman, Homi Bhabha• Social Reformers: e.g., B.R. Ambedkar, Raja Ram Mohan Roy, Savitribai Phule• Artists and Cultural Icons: e.g., M.S. Subbulakshmi, Amrita Sher-Gil, Lata Mangeshkar• Sportspersons: e.g., Major Dhyan Chand, Mary Kom, P.T. Usha• Political Leaders and Visionaries: e.g., Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel, Indira Gandhi, Narendra Modi• Other Influential Figures: Regional heroes, folk artists, educators, environmentalists, etc.• Students are encouraged to select personalities from different Indian states to reflect the cultural and regional diversity of the nation.
5	Eligibility	The event is open to all enrolled students of the university across all departments and disciplines.

6	Rules	<p>PRESENTATION FORMAT This is a speaking competition, and participants can choose one of two formats:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Role Play / Monologue: Dress as the chosen personality and deliver a first-person narrative. The student should speak as if they are the personality, highlighting their key life events, challenges, and contributions. • Narrative Presentation: Speak in third person, sharing the story, impact, and legacy of the selected figure without dressing up. <p>GENERAL RULES</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Time Limit: 3 to 5 minutes per participant. • Language: Participants can present in Hindi or English. Regional quotes or expressions may be used with translations if needed. • Originality: Content must be original. Plagiarism or reading directly from online sources will lead to disqualification. • Dress Code (Optional): Traditional or character-based attire relevant to the selected personality is encouraged but not mandatory. • Visual Aids: Use of small props, posters, or hand-held visuals is allowed but should not interfere with the speech. <p>JUDGING CRITERIA</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Content accuracy and depth of research • Clarity of speech and expression • Creativity and engagement • Relevance to theme and cultural representation • Overall presentation and confidence <p>LOGISTICS AND SUPPORT</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A registration link/form will be circulated two weeks prior to the event. • Participants must submit their chosen personality and format at the time of registration. • Basic AV support will be provided (microphones, podium, projector if needed). • Faculty mentors will be available for feedback or guidance upon request.
