DIORAMA

A scale or miniature model/ Diorama is most generally a physical representation of an object, which maintains accurate relationships between all important aspects of the model. This enables it to demonstrate some behaviour or property of the original object without examining the original object itself. The most familiar scale models represent the physical appearance of an object in miniature, but there are many other kinds.

The Dioramas are then used for photograph modelling such that the photographs of the miniatures appear to be a real scale object. The effects are generated either optically when the photograph is taken, or by digital post processing. Many diorama effect photographs are taken from lower angles to simulate the effect of looking up on a miniature.

MATERIAL / MEDIUM:

The participants can use any material as long as it is used to create a model and not the real object intended to be photographed.

SETUP:

- 1. Only individual participation is allowed.
- 2. Each team has to design an art form on their respective topic.
- 3. The art form should be able to depict the given topic or the art form can also depict the solution for the given topic.
- 4. The participant then has to photograph the created model to make it appear as real as possible.
- 5. The time frame allotted is of 180 Minutes.

RULES AND REGULATIONS:

- 1. Prior registrations are compulsory and the intended teams are required to register at
- 2. Only the model would have to be assembled at the time of the competition. No extra time for concept formulation.
- 3. Photography shall be done by self-owned cameras/devices of participants. The submission of the photographs would be digital on the provided email IDs.
- 4. Decision of the jury is final.
- 5. In case of live competitions, the contests will be conducted on an online basis through the use of video apps and the participants have to ensure their presence for the entire duration of the competition and will send their entries via e-mail to the provided email addresses.
