





Amity School of Architecture and Planning OK DOODLE

DESCRIPTION

Doodles are simple drawings that can have concrete representational meaning or may just be composed of random and abstract lines, generally without ever lifting the drawing device from the paper, in which case it is usually called a "scribble". In this event the individuals are tested upon their creative skills to create a theme-based doodle using a micron pen. This activity shall help the participants to enhance their creative streak and imagination.

MATERIALS / MEDIUM

Only hand-drawn sketches are permitted. **USE OF SOFTWARE FOR EDITING, COMPOSITION OR IN ANY WAY ENHANCING THE SKETCH WILL LEAD TO DISQUALIFICATION.**

SET UP:

- 1. The event is based on an individual's creative thinking and skill judgement.
- 2. Each design would be theme-based which shall be given on the spot.
- 3. The event will take place on 8th May, 2020.
- 4. The time frame allotted is of 180 Minutes, (10:00 AM to 1:00 PM) which includes the time required to make each submission also. No extra time shall be provided.
- 5. All the participants can see their entries on the Instagram page (@culturalsocietyasap) after the jury.
- 6. The results will be announced on 11th May, 2020 from 2:00 PM onwards.
- 7. The closed jury would be conducted post the event on the same day.
- 8. Sheet size should be one A3 or two A4 sheets combined vertically.
- 9. The format for the attachment should be JPEG and should not exceed 3 MB.
- 10. The participants have to send their entries on culturalsociety.asap@gmail.com by 1:00 PM maximum. Any entries beyond the provided time limit would be penalised.

RULES

- 1. Only individual participation is permitted and the intended teams are required to register at https://www.amity.edu/ayf/Arts.aspx
- 2. On the spot entries will not be entertained and prior registrations are compulsory.
- 3. It is compulsory to doodle without lifting the pen and non-compliance shall lead to disqualification.
- 4. Reproduction of existing ideas or designs will lead to disqualification.
- 5. Decision of the jury is final.

6. As all the competitions are online, they will be conducted on <u>Microsoft Teams</u> software so the participants have to be ready with their Microsoft Teams ID beforehand.
