SUMMER CAMP 2023 Date: 15th-31st May' 2023

The camp aimed to help children spend their time productively while also providing a relaxing environment. The camp was inaugurated by the School Principal, Mrs. Rachna Mishra, who addressed the students and was

followed by a cheerful welcome from the school's cheerleaders. The summer camp offered an assortment of engaging activities. They had the chance to develop their personality and public speaking skills, learn about health, nutrition, and healthy foods, engage role plays and street plays, and explore activities such as colouring, painting, and

painting, and clay modelling.

Sports activities like karate and yoga were also part of the camp, along with workshops on calligraphy, Zentangle, mural art, and photography. Grooming sessions were also conducted to help students improve their overall appearance and self-esteem. The activities and workshops were designed to promote teamwork, fair play, and self-improvement among the students. The participants were divided into four groups based on their classes, labeled as Group A, B, C, and D. The camp started with a photography workshop conducted by Mr. Trilochan S. For public speaking, they were given topics based on a situation and JAM (just a minute session) was also conducted. They spoke confidently and participated with immense enthusiasm. Then they were divided into groups and were given separate topics to perform a skit on. The teachers in charge helped them by giving their valuable inputs and suggestions.

Musically inclined children sung many songs, both in Hindi and

English and got super engrossed in the melodious sessions. During dance session, they enjoyed learning new dance forms which were choreographed to different genres of songs. They polished their hands on musical instruments like the tabla, drums etc.

Acting and dialogue delivery skills of students were enhanced during theatre session. Sessions for practising the Nukkad Natak with the theme, Hasna Zaroori Hai had the new block of school inundate in a laughter riot. Story telling using puppets was greatly enjoyed by junior students. Additionally, students participated in fireless cooking sessions, where they showcased their creativity by



coming up with innovative recipes and trying their hand at different cuisines. STEM activities like making straw animal figures and water dispensers were also conducted, allowing the students to engage in hands-on learning experiences. Grooming sessions taught children basic etiquettes that encompass a wide range of skills like laying a dinner table and practicing good manners.
