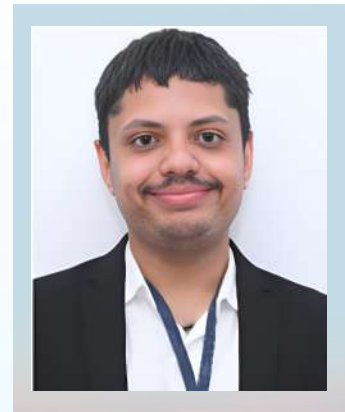

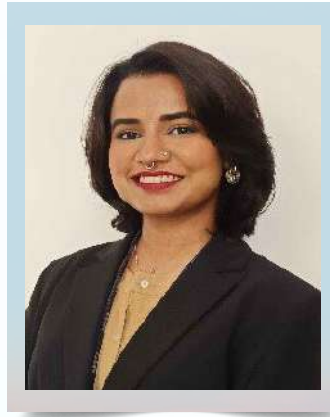

STUDENT INITIATIVES

As part of their commitment to experiential learning, students of the Amity Institute of Public Health and Hospital Administration took the lead in organizing the high-profile panel discussion on “Reimagining Healthcare: The Role of AI and Digital Health in Smart Care” on January 24, 2025. They worked closely with an eminent panel of speakers, including Dr. Suneela Garg, Professor and Head of Community Medicine at Maulana Azad Medical College, and Dr. Vijay Agarwal, President of the Consortium of Accredited Healthcare Organizations (CAHO), along with other distinguished experts — Dr. Suren Shukla, Dr. Saurabh Gehlot, Mr. Satish Kumar, and Dr. Anandhi Ramachandran. From coordinating logistics and managing the auditorium setup to personally welcoming speakers and facilitating smooth audience interaction, students ensured the event ran seamlessly. Through their active engagement, they not only gained rare exposure to national healthcare leaders but also deepened their understanding of AI’s transformative role in diagnostics, patient care, and healthcare operations — an experience that beautifully blended learning with leadership.

In addition to the campus activities, students also organized an outreach program on Breast cancer awareness program at a local school, specifically engaging women and adolescent girls to raise awareness, answer queries, and encourage early preventive practices, thereby extending the impact of the initiative beyond the university. The program fostered an environment of open dialogue, enabling participants to seek clarifications and share concerns in a supportive setting. By integrating academic learning with community engagement, the students not only advanced critical public health messaging but also enhanced their competencies in health communication, event management, and stakeholder collaboration reflecting their preparedness to contribute meaningfully to public health practice

As part of their commitment to community health, environmental responsibility, and worker welfare, students actively participated in a cleanliness awareness training program organized at Atal Park through a collaboration between the municipal corporation and the Sugam Swachhta team. The students presented a short, engaging street play that effectively communicated the critical importance of cleanliness and proper waste management to the local community. Through this creative medium, they educated the audience on managing five specific types of household waste and demonstrated the correct methods for segregation and disposal, emphasizing the environmental and health benefits of responsible waste handling. In addition to public awareness activities, the students also conducted a targeted training session for sanitation workers on occupational hazards and workplace safety, focusing on preventive measures, use of protective gear, and safe waste-handling practices to reduce health risk

ABOUT US

The Master of Public Health (MPH) at AIPH&HA is a two year full-time, four semesters' program, offered within the state-of-the-art Amity University campus in Noida, India. The program has a mix of both core and elective courses. It provides students with a strong foundation in Epidemiology, Biostatistics, Health Economics, Data Management & Analytics, Health Research Methods, Behavioural Sciences, AYUSH, Demography, NCDs, Public Health Planning and Management, Public Health Nutrition, Report Writing, Presentation and other technical and soft skills.

Practical component of the Program: In addition to classroom-based learning, students are exposed to a variety of community and industry-based exposure. They gain practical experience through mandatory internship and dissertation activities. A two-month summer internship at the end of second semester and three-month dissertation during final semester is integral part of the program. These practical components provide the students with ample opportunities to understand practicalities of the prevalent health systems of the developed, emerging and developing economies, and prepares them to contribute towards addressing the contemporary issues of the health systems.

The project is designed to equip students with the necessary skills and knowledge to professionally address healthcare trends or specific issues affecting hospital operations after graduation.

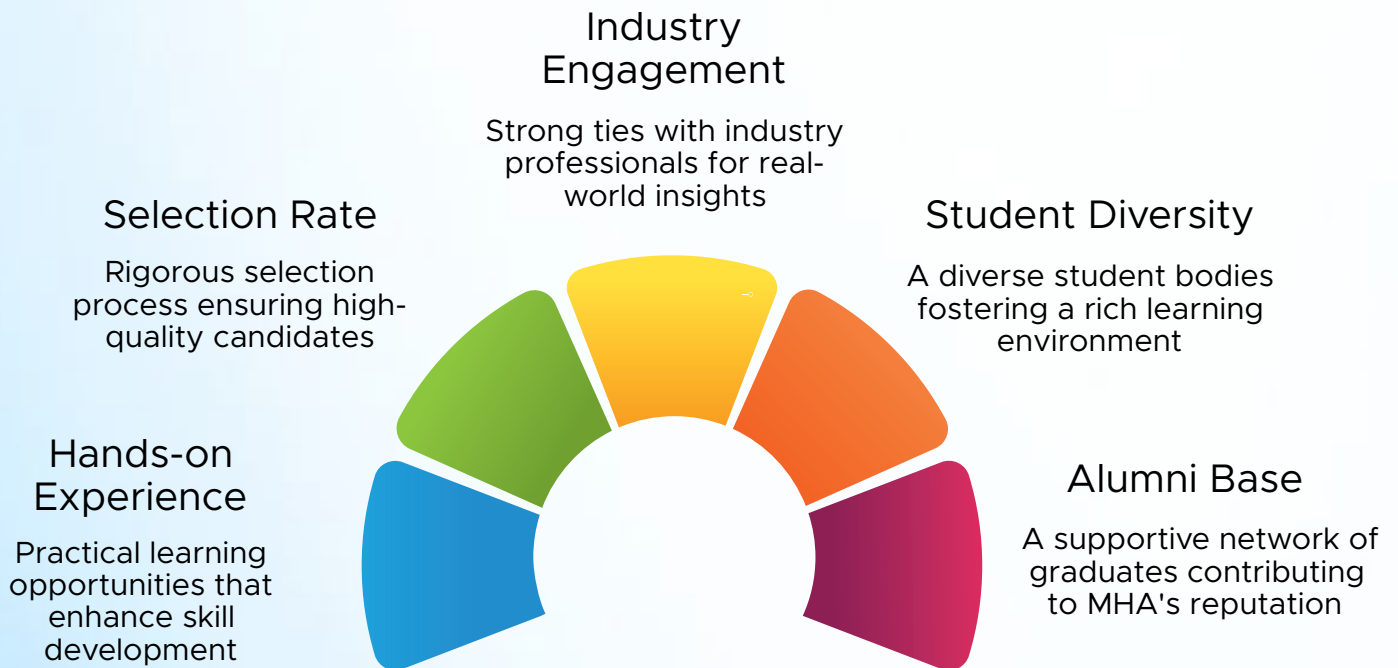

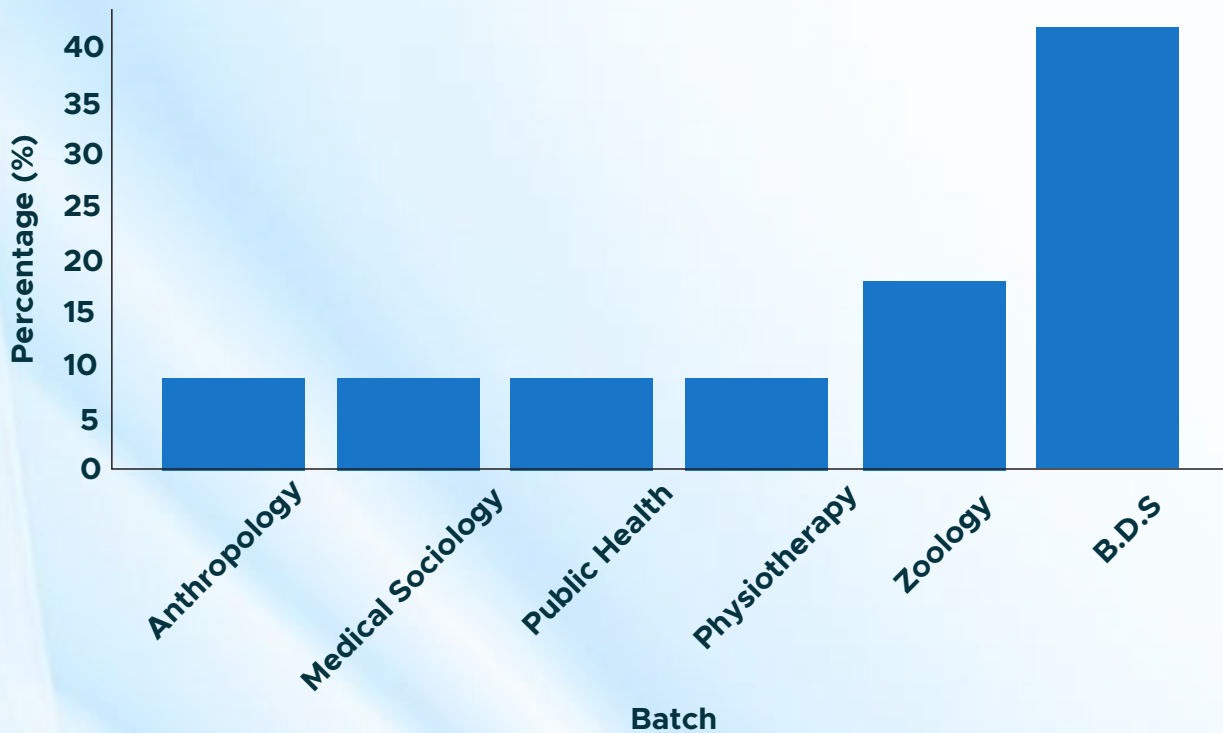

GUIDELINES FOR RECRUITERS

1. The Placement Process of Amity Institute of Public Health & Hospital Administration, AIPH&HA for this year is slated to begin from the Last week of September 2025. The process can be conducted in both offline and online formats as per the convenience of the recruiter. Though offline in person drive will be appreciated.
2. Organizations that wish to recruit from AIPH&HA, will have to communicate their interest to our Deputy Manager – CRC through an e-mail on the official mail ID (dsajnani@amity.edu) of AIPH&HA.
3. To facilitate the slotting process and make the engagement smooth, organizations are requested to provide the following details in their communication.
 - a. Job Description & Position Offered
 - b. Geographical Location of the Job
 - c. Number of Positions Open
 - d. Compensation (CTC) & Other Incentives
4. Organizations willing to recruit from AIPH&HA are expected to give a Pre-Placement Talk to the students. The Preplacement talk can be given on the same day the slot has been assigned to the organization or any other day comfortable for the organization.
5. In case the organization chooses to give the presentation on a day other than the assigned slot, the same should be conveyed to the placement committee in advance, so that appropriate arrangements can be made.
6. Organizations are expected to inform the Placement Committee of the probable nature of the tests, number of rounds it wishes to take, and the expected time duration required to conduct these rounds. The procedure for plotting prospective recruiters for the placement process will be done in accordance to the ranking criteria set by the institute.

7. All organizations will be required to prepare a waiting list in addition to the candidates selected for the roles at the end of the selection process.

8. Organizations must confirm the candidates selected by giving their names in either soft or hard copy duly signed by the company official/HR/talent acquisition team on the same day after finishing the last stage of selection process

9. In case the organization is unable to declare the result on the same day due to unforeseen circumstances, then the student is allowed to participate in other companies & the final status will depend upon who declares the result first.

10. A written confirmation letter from the selected candidates confirming her/his willingness to join the organization needs to be produced within 24 hrs. of the selection. Failing which the organization is requested to extend the offer to the next waitlisted candidate on their list at the earliest. It may choose to not offer as well.

11. The organization shall provide the offer letters to the Placement Committee in official mail and not directly to the students. In case this is an auto generated process then the organization should intimate the Placement Committee about offer release status with date by keeping official mail in loop.



PLACEMENT PROCEDURE

follows the following stages:

Registration

All organizations that are interested in recruiting students are required to communicate their interests via email. The organizations are requested to communicate their interest at the earliest so that we can invite them for pre- placement talk on a mutually convenient date.

Pre-placement Talk

Post successful registration/pre-placement talk, the organizations are given the option of circulating their customized application form or accept the resumes of the interested students.

Slotting

Each organization is allotted a unique date and time on which it can take interviews of the shortlisted candidates. The slot assigned to the organization will be decided by the placement committee based on institute's norms and will be communicated to the organization in advance.

Offers

The acceptance or rejection of the offers by the selected candidates will be communicated to the organisation within the committed time by the placement committee.

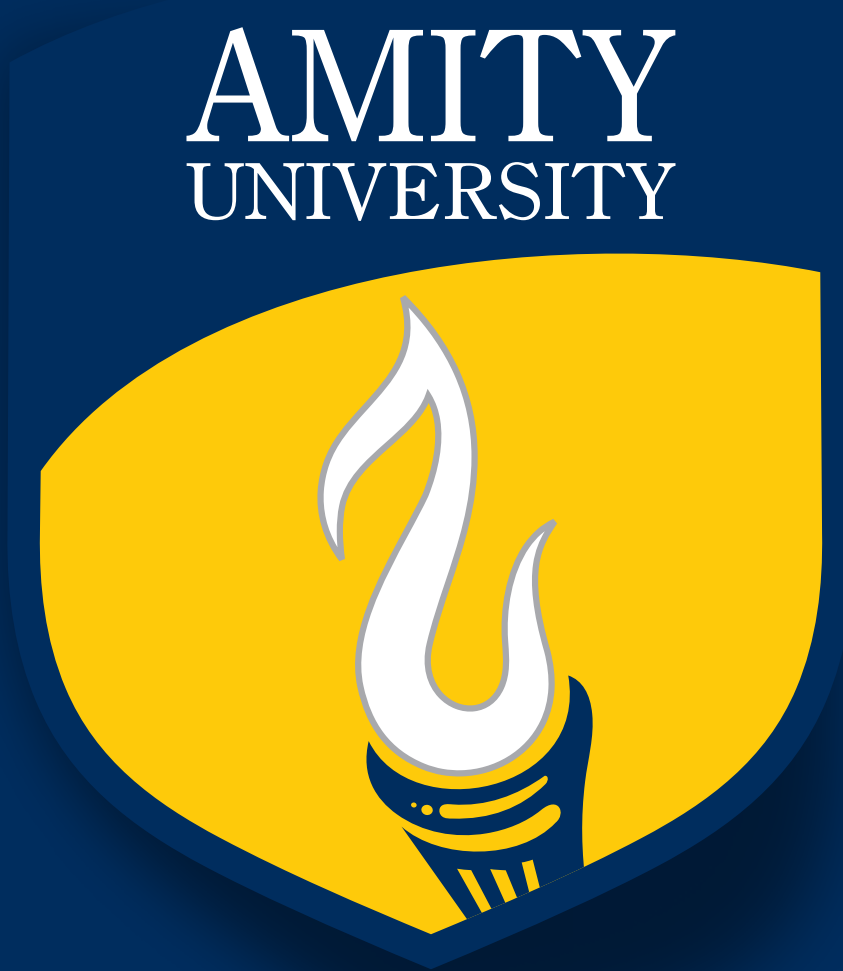
