### **1. Title, place (town, country) and date of the workshop**

Half Day Workshop on “Intellectual Property Rights (IPR)” held on January13, 2017

### **2. About the workshop**

This Workshop is the second workshop under the NRDC IFC scheme at Amity University Haryana. The IFC scheme of NRDC has specific stated objectives though, the scheme has larger scope and it is still evolving.
