

CALL FOR POSTERS

CONFLUENCE-2013

Introduction

Confluence 2013 is organizing a poster session aimed at showcasing work in progress. The poster papers are an independent part of the conference, and are not selected from the main submission of the full length papers. This is an opportunity to present and discuss current work in an informal setting during the Confluence 2013. Posters will be reviewed by Confluence-2013 poster chairs. At the conference, posters must be presented by the respective author(s). The poster papers should describe original and unpublished work and should not be under review for any other conference or journal. This is a great chance especially for researchers to obtain interesting and valuable feedback on ongoing research from knowledgeable scientists, speakers, delegates and academicians at the conference.

Authors are invited to submit original poster papers on any topic relevant to the theme of the conference.

Design and layout specifications:

- The poster size must be 24" x 30". The poster does not necessarily have to fill the entire working area.
- **Participation must be individual or in team of two.**
- Limit the text to about one-fourth of the poster space, and use "visuals" (graphs, diagrams, schematics, maps, etc.) to explain the concept.
- Posters can be oriented either horizontally or vertically.
- Poster can be either manual or printed.
- Poster title should be positioned at the top-center of the poster.
- Author name, department, and Institution should be positioned at Right-bottom of the poster.
- Please submit the poster abstract that explains the main contribution of your work at the time of submission. The poster abstracts: (i) must not exceed a single page, (ii) must be written with 12 point font, (iii) must contain up to one figure, (iv) can refer up to 3 references, (v) must not use section names, (vi) must not contain detailed derivations, and (vii) must limit the use of equations to a necessary minimum.
- Make it obvious to the viewer how to progressively view the poster.
- Poster should be presented within allotted time of 3 minutes.
- Use color to enhance comprehension, not for decoration.

Instructions for Printed Posters:

- Poster title must be 40 pt in Times New Roman.
- Normal text size should be at least 20 pt in Times New Roman.
- Author name, department etc. must be in 14 pt in Times New Roman.
- Each visual should have a caption.

Instructions for Hand Made Posters:

- Text size should be proportional to font sizes and styles in printed posters.
- Diagrams, Graphs, handwriting should be clear.

Best Poster Award:

The award for best poster will be given in the concluding award ceremony of 4th International Conference Confluence 2013 - The Next Generation Information Technology Summit.

Important dates:

Poster Abstract Submission deadline	: 20 th July 2013
Notification of Acceptance	: 25 th July 2013
Final Poster Submission Deadline	: 15 th August 2013
Last Date of Registration	: 15 th August 2013

Send your abstract via email with subject line "POSTER SUBMISSION-"Title of poster"
to Email id: confluence2013@amity.edu. After approval, the final poster should be submitted.
