His principal interests include global & national health policy, financing of health services, regional health planning, and hospital development. His lifetime endeavors have been focused on optimizing the use of technology & human skills in achieving the highest standards of technical efficiency, clinical effectiveness, and quality in the delivery of healthcare.

Extensively traveled over 20 countries of North America, Europe, Africa, Middle East, and South East Asia, Dr. Nagpal is credited for planning and development of nearly 50 hospitals across the Indian subcontinent and the Middle East.
