About the Nukkad:

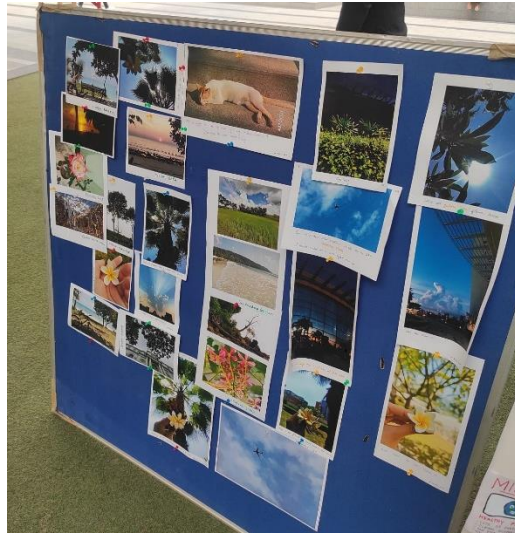
