## ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

### Local Student

**Either Pass in:** 3 Subjects at A level and 1 subject at subsidiary level at Higher School Certificate Examination

**Or Pass in:** 2 Subjects at A level and 2 subjects at subsidiary level at the Higher School Certificate Examination and

**Or Pass in:** 3 subjects at A level at the London General Certificate Examination. International Students requirement HSC or equivalent qualifications acceptable to AIHE or an equivalent qualification are eligible to apply.

Applicants whose medium of instruction at HSC or

equivalent level is not English must provide evidence of their English language proficiency. The level required for study for an undergraduate degree course is IELTS 5.0 or its TOEFL equivalent.
