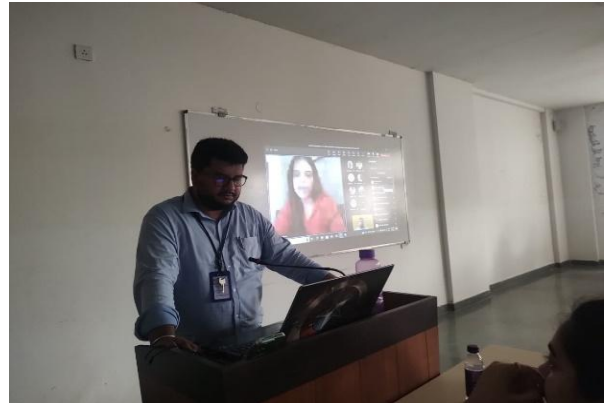
Mr. Pavan D an Artist from Hyderabad interacting with the students.
