Industry Expectations and Skills Requirements




Prof. (Dr). Pradeep Joshi – Group Addl. Pro Vice-Chancellor Director General & Dean welcoming the esteemed guests of the session.


Ms. Vandana Pant, interacting with the students of ASFA.

Mr. Tejeshwar Prasad interacting with students and suggesting students to level up in terms of communication and presentation.


