


## **Amity School of Fine Arts**

## Mr. Kaushik Lohani, Assistant Professor & programme leader starting the session with a welcome vote



Addl. Pro Vice Chancellor, Director General and Dean further said that "industry is dynamic in nature, a lot of opportunities are open for the students".




Prof (Dr.) P. Sasikala, Dean(Academics) and Head, Department of New Media Technology interacting with students.


Mr. Swapan Bhandary, Assistant Professor(Painting) talked about the career opportunities in the field of Fine Arts

Mr. Kaushik Lohani, Assistant Professor (Animation) also talked about the career opportunities in the field of animation.




Mr. Swapan Bhandary, Assistant Professor ASFA talked about the skill development in Fine Arts.

**Day 4, 16<sup>th</sup> May 2024 (Thursday)** 




Ms.Rachita Wason, interacting with the students.


Ms.Bharti Gupta,Lead Designer ,Little Millenium Pvt Ltd


## Dr. Varinder Kaur, Visiting Faculty of ASFA Department talked about the career prospects in Advertising & Design Industry/ VFX


Dr. Geetika Kaw Kher, Assistant Professor, ASFA talked about Higher Education in Fine Arts.

Dr. Abdul Salam Khan, Assistant Professor, ASFA talked about Higher Education in Fine Arts.



Mr.Shankar Sahay ,Head CRC ASFA,ASFT interacted with the students and shared his knowledge about the significance of Communication in the Creative Industry.




Mr. Varun Sahai, Assistant ProfessorASFA interacted with the students and shared the knowledge about Development of Portfolio for the Creative Industry.
