1	Name of Competition	CHILLS AND THRILLS
2	Concept of Competition	An activity where the participants are required to complete their horror stories in 2 rounds using the provided pictures and elements.
3	Eligibility	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● University Students with a valid ID card● School Students from 10th standard to 12th standard with a valid school ID card. <p>(**Uploading of valid ID card is mandatory for AILF 3.0 registration)</p>
4	Rules	<p>General Instructions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Use of unparliamentary words and distasteful language will lead to disqualification● The Jury's decision will be final. No clarifications regarding judgment will be entertained.● The virtual platform details will be shared on the registered email id. Participants are requested to enter the correct email id in the registration form.● All participants will have to join the platform 20-30 minutes before the commencement of the activity and get themselves registered for their presence (Attendance).● Not abiding by any of the instructions will lead to disqualification.

Preliminary Round: -

- The participants will be given a common picture **24 hours** prior to the submission date.
- They are required to make a horror story based on the given picture and leave it on a cliffhanger.
- The judgment will be based on creativity, originality, relevance, expression, and the suspense left on the cliffhanger.
- All the entries should be mailed to ailf.chillsandthrills@gmail.com. The subject of the emails should be the **ACTIVITY NAME**.
- The naming of all documents **should be** in the format: **RegistrationNumber_NameOfParticipant**.
- The **last date** of submission of all entries is **21st June, 2022, 11:59 P.M. IST**.

Round 1: -

- The participants will be given three elements **24 hours** prior to the commencement of the activity.
- They will have to inculcate the elements (elements can be anything) in their stories and complete them.
- They will have to narrate their stories in front of the Judges.
- The maximum time allotted to each participant for enactment will be **1 minute**.
- Judgment will be made based on the creativity, originality, relevance, coherence, expression, and amount of thrills their story gives out.

Final Round: -

- The shortlisted participants will get to express and enact their stories (without any creative boundations) for example they can dress up, and dance.
- The maximum time allotted to each participant for enactment will be **3 minutes**.
- Judgment will be made based on creativity, originality, expression, and enactment.
