<b>1</b>	<b>Name of Competition</b>	<b>RISING STAN LEE</b>
<b>2</b>	<b>Concept of Competition</b>	An activity where the participants are required to find flaws in existing characters and will then have to create a new character on the provided adjectives.
<b>3</b>	<b>Eligibility</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● <b>University Students</b> with a valid ID card.</li><li>● <b>School Students</b> from 10th standard to 12th standard with a valid school ID card.</li></ul> <p><b>(**Uploading of valid ID card is mandatory for AILF 3.0 registration)</b></p>
<b>4</b>	<b>Rules</b>	<p><b>General Instructions:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Use of unparliamentary words and distasteful language will lead to disqualification</li><li>● The Jury's decision will be final. No clarifications regarding judgment will be entertained.</li><li>● The virtual platform details will be shared on the registered email id. Participants are requested to enter the correct email id in the registration form.</li><li>● All participants will have to join the platform <b>20-30 minutes</b> before the commencement of the activity and get themselves registered for their presence (Attendance).</li><li>● Not abiding by any of the instructions will lead to disqualification.</li></ul>

## ACTIVITY SPECIFIC GUIDELINES

### Preliminary Round: -

- The participants are required to send in a write-up describing a flaw in an existing superhero and how the flaw in the character pulls them back.
- The participants will then have to portray the perfect version of their flawless superhero.
- Judgment will be made based on the depiction of the flaw and clarity of the content.
- All entries should be mailed to [ailf.risingstanlee@gmail.com](mailto:ailf.risingstanlee@gmail.com). The subject of the emails should be the **ACTIVITY NAME**.
- The naming of all documents **should be** in the format: **RegistrationNumber\_NameOfParticipant**.
- The **last date** of submission of all entries is **21st June, 2022, 11:59 P.M. IST**.

### Round 1: -

- The participants will be provided three adjectives to create their own Superhero.
- The adjectives will be provided **24 hours** prior to the commencement of the event on their registered mail ids.
- They will also be required to name their superhero.
- The maximum time allotted to each participant for describing their superhero will be **1 minute**.
- Judgment will be based on originality, creativity, profoundness, relevance with the provided adjectives, and relation of the characters.

### Final round:-

- The participants will have to present a skit based on their own superhero they have created in front of the Jury.
- The maximum time allotted to each participant for enactment will be **3 minutes**.
- Judgment will be based on originality, creativity, expression, and relevance to the character.
