<b>1</b>	<b>Name of Competition</b>	<b>GRYPHONS AND GARGOYLES</b>
<b>2</b>	<b>Concept of Competition</b>	An activity where the participants are required to debate between the ultimate battle of good and evil.
<b>3</b>	<b>Eligibility</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● <b>University Students</b> with a valid ID card</li><li>● <b>School Students</b> from 10th standard to 12th standard with a valid school ID card.</li></ul> <p><b>(**Uploading of valid ID card is mandatory for AILF 3.0 registration)</b></p>
<b>4</b>	<b>Rules</b>	<p><b>General Instructions:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Use of unparliamentary words and distasteful language will lead to disqualification</li><li>● The Jury's decision will be final. No clarifications regarding judgment will be entertained.</li><li>● The virtual platform details will be shared on the registered email id. Participants are requested to enter the correct email id in the registration form.</li><li>● All participants will have to join the platform 20-30 minutes before the commencement of the activity and get themselves registered for their presence (Attendance).</li><li>● Not abiding by any of the instructions will lead to disqualification.</li></ul>

## ACTIVITY SPECIFIC GUIDELINES

### Preliminary Round: -

- The participants will have to choose a character of their choice.
- They will have to explain how the character has been portrayed as a villain but is actually a good person.
- Judgement will be made based on expression, relevance, contradiction and how the character has been put up.
- All the entries should be mailed at [ailf.gryphonsandgargoyles@gmail.com](mailto:ailf.gryphonsandgargoyles@gmail.com). The subject of the mails should be the **ACTIVITY NAME**.
- The naming of all documents **should be** in the format: **RegistrationNumber\_NameOfParticipant**.

### Round 1: -

- The participants will then have to elaborate why they chose their desired characters in front of the Jury.
- The time provided to each participant will be **1 minute**.
- Judgement will be made based on expression, relevance, contradiction and how the character has been put up.

### Final Round: -

- The participants will have to debate on good vs evil and which wins it all.
- They have to explain which surpasses the other, the good or the bad.
- Time given to each participant will be **3 minutes**.
- Judgment will be based on their articulation, profoundness, clarity, creativity and relevance of their expression.
