

Guidelines of Pixels

- You may submit maximum 5 entries per theme per person in the contest , Best of 2 will be finalized for judgement and from these best picture will get exhibited .
- There is no restriction on the use of technology; one can use Mobile Phone Camera or DSLR as per their discretion.
- No heavy editing would be accepted by any mean whatsoever. Only basic colour correction is allowed.
- You are required to provide an appropriate caption for the image submitted. Without a caption, the entry will be disqualified.
- The photograph should not have any watermark or identifying feature on it.
- Participants will be judged on the basis of creativity, perspective, presentation, framing and how well they are able to justify the given theme.
- There will be three positions i.e. 1st, 2nd and 3rd in each category. In case of tie among the participants, the jury's decision would be final.
- Submitted photograph must be an original piece of work and all shortlisted participants will have to sign a self-declaration form for the same.
- The host institution shall have the rights to use a part or whole of the entries for academic and promotional purposes.
- Provide the EXIF details of the event .
- Deadline 20th March , 2022 ; 11:59 P.M (No entries will be entertained after this time frame)

TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS AND RESTRICTIONS

- Any equipment capable of taking a photo can be used by the participant.
- No equipment will be provided by the host institution.
- The entry must of the highest resolution possible (Screenshots are not advised).

File format- **JPEG, JPG**

REGISTRATION AND SUBMISSION PROCEDURE

- The entries would be collected through a Google Form link only (Please refer point no.1 of rules and regulations).

- There are separate forms for SCHOOL LEVEL and UNIVERSITY LEVEL categories.
- The participants must submit their entries through the given link, failing which their entries will be cancelled.
