The poems may be submitted via google forms, along with details of the participant. The poems will then be orated during the youth fest and winners announced after judgement.

The poems may be submitted in Hindi or English. Certificate of merit will be provided by the university to the winners of the competition.

- Coherence of form and structure (harmony of words, presentation)
- Clarity of imagery and language
- Physical Presence
- Voice and Articulation
- Dramatic Appropriateness

- Penillion will be conducted from 2 to 5 pm, 24th March 2022.
- Submission of entries will take place via google forms by 22nd March.
