# BIO-BOARD 2022

## (POSTER PRESENTATION COMPETITION)

### (Biosciences and Biotechnology Domain)

Amity Institute of Biotechnology, Amity University Uttar Pradesh is organizing an All India, Inter-Institutional Poster Presentation Competition under the umbrella of our flagship activity, Amity Youth Fest- 2022, which is going to be conducted in hybrid mode this time due to the COVID19-Pandemic. The theme of the poster presentation in the Bioscience and Biotechnology Domain will be based on Lifesciences, Scientific Awareness, and Artistic Creativity however, multidisciplinary work will be encouraged to be showcased in this competition.

The BIO-BOARD 2022 in Bioscience and Biotechnology Domain will be in the following categories:

#### **1) Scientific Posters**

In the scientific category, the poster can be presented on the original research work done by the participant/group (wet or dry lab).

#### **2) Informative Posters**

In the informative category, the poster can be presented on any relevant Scientific information or awareness.

#### **General Guidelines**

- Posters should highlight on the top whether it's 'Scientific Poster' or 'Informative Poster' or 'Artistic Poster'.
- The poster should include the name and institutional affiliation of the author/s.
- Poster should be made in A3 size and in the digital format (JPG/PNG etc.), made in high definition.
- The standard text should be in 'Times New Roman font and the size of the font should not be less than 12.
- Posters need to be presented online using a suitable platform and the author/s will be pre-informed about it.
- Author/s needs to submit the abstract (maximum 300 words) and the digital poster (in PDF format). While sending the abstract and digital poster, the corresponding author needs to specify in the subject line, "BIO-BOARD 2022 Competition-Bioscience and Biotechnology Domain".

- The poster presentation will be done on MS-Teams.
- Material included in the poster should be displayed in logical sequence (Introduction, Objective/s, Materials and Methods, Result, Discussion, and Conclusions, although, other ways of organizing the poster to provide clear ‘take-home messages’, such as questions as headers, can also be used).
- The effectiveness of a poster presentation will be enhanced by using techniques to improve the graphic impact. Please note, however, that simplicity, ease of reading, etc., are more important than artistic flair.
- Avoid overcrowding figures and cramming too many numbers into tables. Legends and titles should accompany all figures, tables, photographs, etc. in order to allow their immediate identification.
- No commercial activities or any advertising to be displayed on the posters.
- Noncompliance with this rule will result in the poster being removed and disqualified from the competition.

### **Eligibility Criteria**

- UG students, PG students, and Research Scholars.

### **Evaluation Criteria**

- Posters will be judged (by a panel of the jury) based on, the optimum amount of information as per the topic, relevant content/supporting results, and presentation of the content.

### **Registration**

The registration can be done on the AYF-2022 website.

**Date of competition- 24<sup>th</sup> to 26<sup>th</sup> March 2022.**

**Results** will be announced on **March 26, 2022** during the Valedictory session.

### **Platform**

- The competition will take place on MS-Teams.
