### **THE ERUDITES' CONFERENCE**

1	<p><b>Brief description of the event:</b> It is a speaking event that is being organized to enhance the participants' research, speaking, debating, and writing skills, along with critical thinking abilities. The students have to participate in pairs. One member of the team would represent the portfolio of the finance minister of a country and other member will be the reporter of the same country. The event will be divided into three rounds. They need to speak on the topics as per their assigned portfolios and their respective countries. The speaking time will be a maximum of 3 minutes, per participant in each round. The reporter needs to make a report of the conference and can ask questions to the finance ministers of other countries.</p>

8	<p><b>Rules and Regulations for the Event:</b></p> <p><b>The Screening Round</b> To shortlist the top 50, we will conduct a quiz on Day 1. The top 50 scorers will advance to the next round.</p> <p><b>Round 1- The Creative Conclave</b> The top 50 will go ahead and participate in the main event. The Topic for Round one is “Creative economy as a development strategy”. The participants will speak and present their comments on behalf of and representing the portfolio that has been assigned to them. The participants will present the views of their respective portfolios one by one. The reporter needs to make a report of the conference which would be submitted to the panelist and would be Judged. To accommodate 50 teams, we will have 5 tracks (10 teams each), being conducted simultaneously.</p> <p><b>Round 2- The Diplomatic Debate</b> There will be a vote for the selection of the topic before Round 2 by the participants. The 2 topics (out of which one will be decided) are “Mobilizing financial resources for developing countries for the orange economy” and “Human Capital Development through Creative Economy”. After every speech in the second round, the speaker will be asked questions by other finance ministers, reporters, and audience members. This would be an elimination round and only 10 teams will go in round 3.</p> <p><b>Round 3- The Draft Duel</b> There will be a face-off between the 10 teams on a topic that would be given on the spot. Top 3 teams would be the winner of The Erudites' Conference.</p>
