RULES AND REGULATIONS

Eligibility

1. Any student from recognized school, university and institution in India shall be eligible to participate.
2. It is necessary for the students to carry their school /university ID identity cards on both days of the events.
3. There will be individual participation.
4. There is no limitation on the number of participations from one institution. (i.e., any number of students can participate from one institute).
5. Participants may use bilingual language during their speech

Registration and Allotment of Constituencies

1. Participants have to complete their Registration by (24th March), 2022 by 23:59 hours IST.

2. The Registration Fee is Rs. 1200/- without accommodation and Rs. 2500 /- with accommodation for students.
3. The Registration shall be done by filling up the Application form,
4. The Registration shall be deemed complete only when the Registration fee has been remitted successfully and the Application form is duly filled. The Fee details would have to be provided in the Application Form.
5. The participants have to fill three preferences for their constituencies in the form. The previous experience of Mock/ Youth Parliaments has to be mentioned in brief in the Registration form.
6. Constituencies would be allotted according to the previous experiences of each participant.
7. Participants should seek confirmation of their registration prior five days of the event.
8. Please note that the registration fees will not be charged from the online participants.
9. Fee once paid is non-refundable.

Structure of the Event

It will comprise of two rounds

1. Parliamentary Discussion Round (11.00AM to 03.00 PM)
2. Bill Making (03.00 PM to 04.00PM)

Mode of the Event

The event shall be held in hybrid mode incorporating both online and offline mode of participation for the students from across the country. The students will connect to the proceedings of the event either by offline or online mode depending upon the option chosen by the student. The arrangements to connect to the proceedings of the event through online mode would be made by the participant himself/herself. The students who take part in the event through offline mode would be allowed to appear and participate in the proceedings of the event on a face-to-face basis.

Procedure of Virtual Mock Parliament

1. The participants shall report for participation at the allotted time.
2. Formal dressing is required. However, it would be appreciated for wearing an attire similar to the politician of their constituency, carried in decent manner.
3. Proper Parliamentary process is followed for discussion. However, there will be Judges/ Executive Board members to judge the performance of their respective committees.
4. .Participants creating any kind of indiscipline shall be disqualified on the discretion of the judges.
5. .Participants thereby should adhere by the rules and regulations of the event.
6. .The authority to procedural changes during the virtual mock parliament shall rest with the judges and the Organizing Committee.

Evaluation Criteria

1. Parliamentary Discussion Round

- A- Opening Statement- Knowledge and interpretation of Facts; Extent of Research; Confidence- 20 marks(Maximum)
- B- Asking substantive questions- 2 Marks each
- C- Replying Substantive questions- 2 marks each.
- D- Correction in Factual Inaccuracy- 1 Mark each.

2. Bill Making Round

- A.** Valuable Suggestions – 2 marks each.

Prizes

Each Committee will declare three cash prizes as follows-

- 1) Best Delegate
- 2) High Commendation
- 3) Special Mention

Participation Certificates will be given to all Participants.

Miscellaneous

1.The O.C. reserves the right to amend, modify, change, or repeal any of the event rules at any stage. The O.C. shall communicate any changes made in the event rules to the Participants.

2. The Faculty Convenor's and Student President's decision shall be final in all matters concerning the competition.
