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FINANCIAL FACTS

- Investment management companies must register with the SEC and accept fiduciary responsibility for their clients if they manage assets worth more than \$25 million.
- The largest investment management firm has \$1.8 trillion in assets under management.
- The oldest investment management firm is 84 years old.
- The S&P 500 gained 27% in 2009 a phenomenal year. Yet 66% of investors thought it fell that year.
- The average return on investment for all mutual funds was 10.16% for the 10-year period ending December 31, 2019.

FINANCIAL TERMS

- ALPHA: Alpha is the amount of return expected from an investment from its inherent value.
- ASSET ALLOCATION: It refers to the process of dividing investments among cash, income and growth buckets to optimize the balance between risk and reward based on investment needs.
- CUSTODIAN: A bank that holds a mutual fund's assets, settle all portfolio trades and collects most of the valuation data required to calculate a fund's net asset value (NAV).
- GREEN BONDS: Are a type of fixed income instrument that is specifically earmarked to raise money for climate and environmental friendly projects.
