Anna Davey was awarded her Bachelor of Science Degree with Honours in 1980 and was employed as a hospital scientist at the Royal Children's Hospital in Melbourne. In 1984, she was awarded the Lady Latham Research Fellowship, which allowed her to conduct genetic research and which culminated in the Master of Science degree in 1986.

Between 1986 and 1988 Anna worked as a Research Officer in the Centre for Early Human Development at Monash University.

In 1988, Anna was employed by the then State Forensic Science Laboratory as part of a small team formed to introduce DNA profiling to Victoria for criminal casework. By 1994, she was Team Leader and had developed an interest in education and training in forensic science. In 1997, she moved from casework to lead the section of the laboratory responsible for quality management, education and training. In 1997 Anna completed a Certificate IV in Competency Based Training and Assessment and in 1998 a Graduate Certificate of Public Sector Management. In addition to her science, management and training qualifications, she completed a Graduate Diploma in Legal Studies at the University of New England in 2009.

From 2000 - 2004, Anna held the position of Executive Officer of the National Institute of Forensic Science and in 2004 was appointed Deputy Director. In these roles she developed a particular interest in the interface between experts & the law and quality management in science.

In 2008 Anna Davey founded Forensic Foundations, a specialised service aimed at assisting both scientific and legal practitioners broaden and deepen their skills. Anna operates in all areas of the forensic sciences focusing on quality management, the interface between science and the legal system and forensic science based R&D.

Anna is a past Vice President (Australia), Australian and New Zealand Forensic Science Society and is a Council member, Victorian Chapter, Australian Academy of Forensic Sciences.
