- The School Average of class XII of the 2020-21 batch was an impressive 91.96%.
All the 111 students scored distinctions.
- Saloni Gupta topped the school and Commerce stream with 99.2%
- Durgesh Nandini topped the Science stream with 98.4 %
- Ishita Duggal was the Humanities Topper with 98.4%

- Keerthi, a Humanities student with impaired vision and eye related complications scored 97.4%
- 80 students scored above 90%
- 12 students scored a perfect 100

You will be delighted to know that our students have found firm footing in the country's and the world's best institutions.

Our class X students also exhibited their remarkable potential. The school average for the session 2020-21 was 92.75%.

59 students scored a perfect 100.

4 students, Anika Bali, Lakita Gupta, Prince Mittal and Shreyash Raj scored a whopping 99.6%
