

Guest Lecture on Gender Sensitisation

A Guest Lecture on “Gender Sensitisation” was held at ASE on 30th of January 2020 at 1:30pm. Ms. Jyotsna Roy, Founding Director and Chief Executive Officer TARAA – HUMAN DEVELOPMENT AND FACILITATION CONSULTANTS (P) Ltd.



She began the session by conducting a reading exercise for the audience, referring to how there is insufficient representation of females in the parliament and also how stereotypes regarding gender bias still prevail. Ms. Jyotsna briefed about Social inclusions, gender equality, and community empowerment by walking the audience through her experiences in different countries like Ethiopia, Nepal, Bhutan etc. Making it easy for economics students, she even linked macroeconomics and gender sensitisation and talked about the Gender Gap Report along with the changing economy. She conducted another activity in which the students were asked to enlist what parents' routine, eventually inferring to gender rules, gender bias, assessing value of reproductive roles.

The session was followed by an extensive discussion about gender policies, neutral policies respective practical and strategic gender needs and interests.
