

He launched his label, Twig Tie, as an online brand, specializing in bespoke men's suits and Indian ethnic wear in August, 2018. He set up a small studio in Noida where he designs trendy menswear for the young and the young-at-heart. He sells his designs across India and overseas as well.

Anurag told the students that the secret of his success is that he dared to take the first step. He motivated the students with a simple philosophy which is- "To Get Started instead of Just Dreaming". He said that if he was able to do it then so can they.

Students got an opportunity to interact with their senior on a personal level. They asked many questions. They wanted to know about ways to set their designs apart from other competitors, digital media, quality and finishing, achieving the right fit, building customer base; promoting the brand and many such things. Anurag answered each question with a lot of honesty and passion.
