1. Colours of Joy at Kalamkaar which has artworks from FN Souza, Amrita Shergil, Hussain, Anjali Ela Menon and many more contemporary artists.
2. Mycielial Legacies by Anant Art Gallery - Which represents 80 artworks made by the women artists from Faculty of Fine arts, Baroda at CCA.
3. Exhibition by Sumit Roy and other budding Artists. This exhibition is a multi-disciplinary artshow of 9 super special artists have exhibited at Living Traditions Centre (LTC)
4. Rajeevika's Craft Bazaar - Crafts of Rajasthan are displayed and for sale at the crafts mela near Chor Bizarre.
5. There were Textiles & interior displays by few Entrepreneurs which had very innovative concepts
6. Bikaner House also inaugurated its one of a kind Sculpture park displaying an array of sculptures and installations by eminent Indian sculptors/artists at the CCA lawns.
