Mr. Vikas Singh is one of the leading Senior Advocates of the Supreme Court of India and the President of the Supreme Court Bar Association, for a record third term. During his long and accomplished career as a legal luminary, Mr. Singh has also served as the Additional Solicitor General, Government of India.

Mr. Singh is widely admired for his immense in-depth knowledge, perseverance and complete focus on getting speedy and impactful judgements through his oratory and argumentative veracity. His re-election as President of the Supreme Court Bar Association, a very prestigious position by itself is a testimony of his professional reputation and popularity.

Mr. Singh has always been engaged in supporting the Bar Association by contributing generously towards medical help and healthcare of needy lawyers. He has also been a visiting faculty member in the Indian Parliament for giving lectures on various issues including legislative drafting and legal education.

He regularly appears pro-bono in matters relating to important issues where the larger national or public interest is at stake.

He is the only lawyer in India who has been associated with three prominent temple cases in India, i.e., the Ayodhya Ram Temple, Guru Ravidas Temple at Tughlaqabad and Balayogi Shri Sadanand Maharaj Ashram in Maharashtra, emerging victorious in all three of them. He has also dealt with multiple milestone cases including those concerning Administrative, Constitutional, Company, Taxation and Criminal Law, which has paved way for historical judgements.

Mr. Singh is also an avid tennis player and has even played at a tournament at Wimbledon hosted by the International Lawn Tennis Club of Great Britain.

Mr. Singh is very active in social causes especially in providing help to the disabled and is the Chief Patron of the Delhi Foundation of Deaf Women as well as in the treatment of handicapped children.
