1.	Name of Competition	<b>All the world on a stage</b>
2.	Host Institute	Amity Institute of English Studies & Research
3.	Brief Description of Competition	<p>Students in groups (minimum 5) take themes, snippets, or characters from English dramas, and by transplanting them into an Indian setting, reshape them to address current issues such as caste and class discrimination, gender issues, and more, linking them to the overarching theme of Viksit Bharat . They should resonate well with audiences and should capture their attention and imagination.</p> <p>Selection Procedure</p> <p>Round 1 Participants will send soft copies of their script by last week of January (Date will be specified)</p> <p>Round 2 Shortlisted students' groups (minimum 5) will enact excerpts from their scripts on the stage in front of eminent jurors from across the world, in 3 minutes. They should resonate well with audiences, as they easily capture their attention and imagination.</p> <p>Round 3</p> <p>Shortlisted groups will present their final drama in 5 minutes</p>
4.	Topics (if any)	Topics will be relevant and connected to 'Viksit Bharat' theme
5.	Eligibility	<p>Participants must be students currently enrolled at any school or University with a valid ID card of the institution.</p> <p>College/University (18years and above)</p> <p>Students from across India will take part in these competitions.</p>
6.	Rules	<p>Participants must produce their own original scripts in the adapted plays. Productions typically include multiple characters with some form of rising/falling action.</p> <p>Plays must not contain anything pornographic, excessively vulgar, or are violent for the sake of violence.</p> <p>It is compulsory to use English language throughout the drama presentation. Use of vulgar words is strictly prohibited.</p> <p>Scripts must not touch on sensitive issues such as race, religion, politics, colour, personalities, etc.</p>
7.	Schedule (Date and Time) of the competition date	<p>Preliminary Rounds - 29 February 10am -5pm</p> <p>Final round 1 March 10am -5pm</p>
