Participants may be assigned specific roles (e.g., Prime Minister, Opposition Leader) or choose their roles, promoting diverse perspectives within the mock parliament. 5. Debates follow a structured format, allowing participants to present arguments, counterarguments, and engage in cross-examination to simulate real parliamentary proceedings. 6. All participants must adhere to a code of conduct, promoting fair play, integrity, and a positive competition environment.
