Participants, including students and researchers, present their research findings, methodologies, and outcomes in a concise and visually appealing format.</p> <p>Judging criteria will encompass clarity of presentation, scientific merit, creativity in design, effective communication of results, and the ability to engage and articulate complex concepts to both expert and non-expert audiences</p>

5.	Eligibility	UG students, PG students and Research Scholars.

Rules	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Posters should highlight on the top whether it's 'Academic Poster' or 'Scientific Poster'. ● The poster should include the name and institutional affiliation of the author/s. ● Poster should be made in A1 size. ● The standard text should be in 'Times New Roman' font and size of the font should not be less than 12. ● The poster presentation will be done on 29th February and 1st March 2024 ● Material included in the poster should be displayed in logical sequence (Introduction, Objective/s, Materials and Methods, Result, Discussion and Conclusion, although, other ways of organizing the poster to provide clear 'take home messages', such as questions as headers, can also be used). <p>The effectiveness of a poster presentation will be enhanced by using techniques to improve the graphic impact.</p> <p>Please note, however, that simplicity, ease of reading, etc. are more important than artistic flair.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Avoid overcrowding figures and cramming too many numbers into tables. Legends and titles should

		<p>accompany all figures, tables, photographs, etc. to allow their immediate identification.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No commercial activities or any advertising to be displayed on the posters. Non-compliance with this rule will result in the poster being removed and disqualified from the competition.
