3.	Brief Description of Competition	Under the Udbhav competition, four types of mini competitions will be organized which include client consultation, debate, poetry recitation and photography competitions.
4.	Topics (if any)	Empowered Identity: Women's Progress and the Connection of Cultures
5.	Eligibility	Students of all subjects can participate
6.1.	Rules <u>(Client counselling)</u>	<p>It is clarified that the participants are permitted to provide legal advice to their clients only with reference to the laws prevailing in their place of residence and country.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Participants are advised to keep in mind the professional rules of ethics and conduct, as applicable to lawyers, and act in accordance with them during the rounds. • Each team will have 2 members (only). The second member of the team will be appointed by the core committee only. • Change is prohibited after team formation. • A team code will be given to each team by the host organization after registration on the day of the event. The allotted team code will remain effective till the final round. • The decision of the judges will be final and binding. <p>Structure of the event: -</p> <p>This event will be organized at two levels. They are as follows: -</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The challenge will consist of a preliminary round, after which only 5 teams will advance from the preliminary round to the next round. • The winner of the final round will be decided based on the highest absolute score in the final round and will be declared the winner of the challenge.
6.2.	Rules (Debate)	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Student of any discipline can register for the same 2. There will be 2 rounds in the competition. 3. Out of the total teams, the top 5 scoring teams will advance

		<p>to the final round.</p> <p>5. Each team should prepare the pros and cons of the topic and for the final-round the topic will be given to the team 10 minutes before the round.</p> <p>(Detailed rules for execution of each round will be shared at the time of registration at the venue itself, thus, it is mandatory to reach the venue or digital platform at least one hour before the start of the event)</p>
6.3.	Rules (Poetry)	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The competition is open to all types of students. 2. Each participant can submit maximum 1 poem. 3. Poems must be original creations of the participant and must be previously unpublished. 4. The poem should be in Hindi language. 5. Each submission must include the poet's name, contact information and a brief biography and the submission must be made 2 days before the event. <p>there will be 2 rounds</p> <p>6.Round 1 – Self-written poem</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • In this round, participants will have to recite a self-composed poem and submit a printed document of the same. • Each participant will be given maximum 5 minutes to recite his poem. <p>7.Round 2 – Tribute to the Poets</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The participant will have to recite a poem written by a famous poet (whom you are inspired by). • Each participant will have maximum 5 minutes <p>8. The participants will have to present their poems to the judges, on the basis of which the participants will be evaluated and awarded.</p> <p>9. Entrants are encouraged to review and understand these rules prior to submitting their entries. The success of the competition depends on adherence to these guidelines, fairness and transparency in the entire process.</p>
6.4.	Rules (Photography)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The participant will be required to bring his own equipment for taking photographs. • The photo can also be taken with your phone or camera as per your discretion. • The photographer will be allotted appropriate space to take photographs. <p>Participants will be given 1 hour to click photographs and 30 minutes to submit</p>

		<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Photographs must be taken within the boundaries and limits of the allotted space.• A total of 3 images can be submitted per photographer, which must be accompanied by a short descriptive paragraph.
