




# **STUDENT ACHIVEMENTS**

The year also witnessed the students registering their presence in several academic and non academic events both on and off the campus. The notable achievements of the students during the period have been:





## **RESEARCH HIGHLIGHTS**

### I. Project Title: Semi-Automatic toe/heel operated water discharge system

In terms of discharge, the out-flow of grey water from the bathroom or washroom while in use that spills over the floor is a major concern. The *'water drain grating'* that are available in the market, are perforated in nature. And the area of the cut-out is constant for any *'water drain grating'*. If any garbage/dirt is collected on the *'water drain grating'* while in the bathroom or washroom, it becomes difficult for the grey water to pass through these gratings. And in such a case, the dirt must be removed by hand, foot, or tool; once the dirt is removed, only proper graywater flow is possible. To overcome the problems associated with the existing *'water drain grating'*, a new device titled "Semi-Automatic toe/heel operated water drain grating and being completely toe/heel of foot operated.



#### **II. Project Title: Helping Hand**

This project aims to improve the facilities that provide care for road accidents. In today's fast-paced world, we are in a hurry to get somewhere, and as a result, many accidents occur, often resulting in instant death. If an injury occurs, crowds gather to see what happens, but no one comes to help them. As a result, we devised a solution to create software in which anyone passing by that road can take a picture or video and upload it to our site, from which we can trace that location and send immediate help from the nearest help, as well as a SOS to the nearest police station.





## **COURSE PREPAREDNESS OF FACULTY**

University's Quest for Excellence, desire to bring global trends in the curricula and extensive use of IT enabled teaching and learning practices, has resulted in preparing students with well-honed skills compatible with the Global Market.

At Amity, Quality Teaching is fostered with the use of innovative pedagogical techniques to produce learning outcomes for students. It involves several dimensions, like the effective design of curriculum and course content, a variety of learning contexts (including guided independent study, project-based learning, collaborative learning, experimentation, etc.), soliciting and using feedback, and effective assessment of learning outcomes. It also involves well-adapted learning environments and student support services.

Fostering quality teaching is a multi-level endeavor at Amity. Support for quality teaching is practiced and monitored at three interdependent levels:

- <u>Individual level</u>: including initiatives that help teachers achieve their mission, encouraging them to innovate and to support improvements in student learning and adopt a learner-oriented focus.
- <u>Program level</u>: comprising actions to measure and enhance the design, content and delivery of the programs within a department or a school.
- <u>At the Institution level</u>: including projects such as policy design, and support to organisation and internal quality assurance systems.

Amity prepares students for entry to an environment that is characterised by greater uncertainty, speed, risk, complexity and interdisciplinary working and equip them with appropriate skills, knowledge, values and attributes to thrive in it. There is a strong drive to build and create knowledge together with an understanding of working life and reformulate the concept of knowledge in learning situations. Strong connections with working life through different academic projects provide authentic opportunities to learn both generic and professional competencies as well as to build networks and pathways for employment after graduation.

The salient points of the pedagogy are:

- 1. Detailed Course Delivery Plan
  - a. Learning objectives of the course.
  - b. Continuous assessment scheme, i.e. components, schedule and feedback.
  - c. Common thread through the course objectives, syllabus, pedagogy and the assessment scheme.
  - d. Listing topic wise allocation of sessions.
  - e. List of text and references (numbers and quality).
- 2. Power Point Presentations for all the sessions (1 credit course requires 10-12 hours of teaching and for one-hour teaching, ideally 6-8 slides).

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- 3. Other Teaching Material
  - a. Teaching notes and material in addition to the prescribed text.
  - b. Guidelines on short projects.
  - c. Write-up on term paper.
  - d. Relevant articles and papers.
  - e. Tutorial sheets, as defined in the program structure.
  - f. Experiments to be carried out in labs, their objectives and methodology.
  - g. Use of videos/ films, including the objective to be achieved.
- 4. Making the Course Practice Oriented
  - a. Field/industry visits, their planning, objectives and summary report leading to evaluation.
  - b. Projects.
  - c. Case studies and other exercises.
  - d. Guest lectures/panel discussions.
- 5. General guidelines for students regarding attendance, punctuality, meeting the deadlines, chamber consultation hours, prior self-study to be undertaken etc.
- 6. Finally, the efforts are made to judge how much rigor the course has created for the students. In a professional program, normally the mandate is that a student has to put in 2-3 hours of self-study for each hour of classroom teaching.

## SYSTEM OF EDUCATION

#### Semester System

Amity University follows a semester system, which is in conformity with the global practices and standards. The Course curriculum of one year is taught in two semesters, i.e. 17-18 weeks each. The Semester system promotes greater interaction between faculty members and students and permits more meaningful term paper and research assignments.

#### Grade System

The level of students' academic performance is the aggregate of continuous evaluation & the end term examination and is reflected by letter grades on a Ten Point Scale. Letter grades (A+, A, A-, B+, B, B-, C+, C, F) have points associated with them in quantified hierarchy and have qualitative meaning. Semester Grade Point Average (SGPA) & Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) are calculated based on the students' performance in Semester(s) & overall performance, respectively.

Amity University follows Absolute Grading as well as Relative Grading depending upon the strength of students in a particular program & batch. Students are required to maintain minimum SGPA & CGPA to pass a semester and promotion to the next semester and qualify for Degree/Diploma.

#### 100% Attendance

Every student in Amity University is required to achieve 100% attendance in all the Lectures, Tutorials and Practicals and Seminars arranged for the respective course during the semester. However, a relaxation up to a maximum of 25% is granted in case of contingencies. A minimum of 75% attendance is required to appear in the examinations. 100% attendance criteria ensure academic excellence, disciplinary approach and growth of the student.

## **INTERNAL EVALUATION SYSTEM**

The scheme of examinations & evaluation is one of the most important components of judging the academic performance and development of the students. Therefore, in Amity, the students are assessed at regular intervals. 30% weightage is given to continuous/internal assessment in a semester wherein 3-4 evaluation components with weightages are defined. It covers Class Test, Viva, Quiz, Case Discussion /Presentation /Analysis, Home Assignment, Project, Seminar, Term Paper, Attendance etc.

## **CURRICULA & SYLLABI**

The detailed course curriculum of all the programs in Amity University is reviewed at regular intervals as per the industry requirements. For this, many points are considered such as feedback reports on the placements, employability of the passed-out students, latest developments in the technology, statutory compliances of various bodies, etc. The course syllabus is first examined and evaluated by an expert committee which is then reviewed by the Board of Studies of the institution for recommendations to the Academic Council for approval.

The Program Structure is prepared for each Program that includes a semester-wise course (core and electives) to be taught, any internship to be undergone, project/dissertation as per requirement of the program curricula. Each course contains details of the course code, classroom hours, practical/lab classes, tutorials, self-study hours and credit units.

The credit units attached to each course are defined in terms of contact hours, i.e. Lectures (L), Tutorials (T) and Practicals (P). Towards earning credits in terms of contact hours, 1 lecture and 1 tutorial per week are rated as 1 credit each and 2 practical hours per week are rated as 1 credit. In a full-time degree Program, a student is required to earn on an average 25-30 credit units per semester. The credit units attached to Summer Internship/Training (8-10 weeks), fieldwork etc. are included in this total.

As a mandatory requirement, 'Boards of Studies' are constituted for each Institution after approval of the President for the structuring of Academic Programs, viz. framing of Curricula, Syllabi, and Scheme of Evaluation, etc. The Various Boards of Studies hold their meetings and after rigorous scrutiny, the course structure and curricula of the Academic Programs offered are implemented with the approval of the Academic Council.

## **CHOICE BASED CREDIT SYSTEM**

In accordance with the guidelines of the University Grants Commission, Amity University has implemented the Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) Programme in which the students

have a choice to choose from the prescribed courses, across the courses being offered by the University, which are referred as core, elective or minor and they can learn at their own pace and the entire assessment is graded-based on a credit system.

The basic idea is to look into the needs of the students with the aim to keep themselves up-todate with development of higher education in India and abroad. CBCS aims to redefine the curriculum keeping pace with the liberalisation and globalisation in education. CBCS allows students an easy mode of mobility to various educational institutions spread across the world along with the facility of transfer of credits earned by students.

## **MONTHLY STRUCTURED MEETINGS**

With an aim to build a sense of community and engage all stakeholders in decision making, as well as to improve the governance of various facts of academics & administration, structured meetings are being organized every month with stakeholders as below:

- I. Meeting with Teaching HOIs- Every first Thursday of Month- To discuss/resolve the issues and strengthening of the Academics Matters.
- II. Meeting with Non-Teaching HODs- Every second Thursday of Month- To discuss/resolve the issues related to general administration and other non-academics issues.
- III. Meeting with Students Representatives- Every third Thursday of Month- To discuss/resolve the issues of students related to academics and infrastructure facilities including mess, sports, extra curriculum activities etc.



## **BEST PRACTICES**

AUP has implemented many best practices to transform and empower students from a variety of backgrounds. Practices such as learning through experience, Talks by Experts, Mentoring and Counselling, Internal Quality Assurance Cell activities, Value Added Courses and Outcome-Based Education, to name a few.

AUP has setup department-wise Industry Advisory Council with an objective to establish interface between industry and academia to assure very strong industry engagement. Amity Innovation Incubator has also been established and is fully operational to develop innovation and entrepreneurship.

Aside from these, AUP also instills environmental awareness and responsibility in students.

Domain experts of the department have gone through on-going programmes and redesign their Programme Outcomes and Course Outcomes in line with university vision and mission. Departments have inculcated outcome-based education, attainment of courses among its faculty members where each course is explained in detail including teaching pedagogy, assessment design and required rubrics.


## **On Campus Placement Status**

The University witnessed a remarkable growth of 80% in the highest package offered in the final batch of 2022 and 10% growth in the average package








### **CREATING LEGAL AWARENESS THROUGH VARIOUS EVENTS.**
