



Subject : Pre-Ph.D Course Work (Law) – Syllabus for Research Methodology & Computer Application



Pre-PhD Course Work (Law)

Research Methodology and Computer Application

Research in Law is generally based on Theoretical or Doctrinal methodology of research. Therefore, the Pre-PhD Course Work for a Research Scholar of Law and Legal Studies should be based on concepts and definition of Legal Research, Research Problem, Research Design, Hypothesis, Collection of Data, Analysis of Data, Interpretation of Data, Research Report and Computer Application etc. Since Legal Research is Doctrinal in nature, emphasis is not required on Mathematical and Statistical Analysis of Data but on critical analysis of Statutes, Commentaries, Books, Articles and Case Laws.

Objective: This Course is designed to provide the basic and advanced research methods applicable in Legal Research. It aims to impart knowledge for testing a hypothesis of a causal relationship between variables, to identify the lacunas in statutory laws, to portray accurately the characteristics of an individual, situation or group and identify the impact of laws on human society and vice versa: devising methods and suggestions for improving the application of laws for betterment of human society.

The Learning Outcomes of the Course.

At the end of the Course Work it is expected that the Scholar will be able to:

- Conduct doctrinal and empirical(non-doctrinal) research on any topic needing little guidance from their Guide on the research methodology to the PhD Title.
- Develop most suitable research methodology and tools for their research.
- Use computer and E-Resource in research.
- Analyse quantitative and qualitative data.
- Write research report and present the findings of their research in a systematic manner.
