**General Agenda of the Meeting**

- To review the syllabus of FL-French, FBL-French and B.Tech/M.tech -French
- FL-Korean, FBL-Korean and B.Tech-Korean.

**Minutes of Meeting**

The Board of Studies meeting began with a brief introduction by Prof. Ashok Tiku. He thanked the members and the expert for finding out time to attend the meeting. He briefed the members present about the agenda of the meeting. He, thereafter, invited the external expert to present his views on the proposed changes in FL-French and FL-Korean at UG and PG level and suggest the changes.

**Changes brought about in the syllabus of FL-French course**

The following suggested changes in the FL-French syllabus were introduced and presented by Dr. Mansi:

- FL-French for all UG course: to introduce *Latitude 1* as reference book in addition to the text book *A Propos*. Introduction of App-based learning.
- FBL-French for MBA and all PG course: to introduce *hôtellerie-restauration.com* (Clé International/SEJER-Paris 2006) and *tourisme.com* (Clé International/SEJER-Paris 2004) in addition to the text book *Francais.Com* to give students of MBA domain specific knowledge.
- B.tech/M.tech- French: to introduce *Campus 1* ( Paris : CLE International, 2002.) in addition to the text book *Tech French*.

**Changes brought about in the syllabus of FL-Korean course**


The following suggested changes in the FL-French syllabus were introduced and presented by Mr. Kunal:

- To introduce Sejong Hangukau (National Institute of Korean language) as second text book in addition to Hangukau 1 (Yonsei University).

**Comments by the expert (Dr. Sushant Kr. Mishra):**

- The changes and modification suggested in FL-French, FBL-French and B.tech French was appreciated by the expert. It was noted that at PG/MBA level, student should be given domain specific courses on languages so as to increase their employability.
- The introduction of app based learning and use of various AV resources is the demand of present day scenario, hence it was appreciated and recommended by the expert to include these e-resources for effective teaching.
- The changed proposed for FL-Korean was deliberated upon and it was found by the expert that this new book will indeed add to the quality of teaching.
- More reference materials in FL-Korean could be added.


With this the deliberations on the syllabi of various programmes came to an end and it was recorded that the syllabi of FL-French, FBL-French, B.tech/M.tech- French and FL-Korean, FBL-Korean and B.Tech-Korean were approved by the BOS to be implemented from 2017-2018 year.
