At the outset, the chairman extended warm welcome to all the members. He then asked the Registrar to present the agenda items chronologically and the members can than deliberate upon the items.

Item No. AC 5.1: To confirm the minutes of fourth meeting of Academic Council held on 07 Sep 2012.

The Registrar informed the Council that Minutes of the last meeting were circulated some time back. As no observation was received by Registrar's office, the minutes are now presented to the council for its approval. The Council resolved to approve the minutes.

Item No. AC 5.2: To consider and approve, if thought fit, enhancement of cut off marks in the entry level qualification marks and also to raise intake level in various programs

The point was extensively deliberated by all the members. It was brought out that we are generally following the cut off marks which are being followed by other top Institution/



Universities. Further, Dr. Madhukar, In Charge admissions, informed the Council that cutoff marks is just one of the many criteria which are taken into account before a student is granted final admission. Hence we have ample filters to weed out poor students. It was also pointed out that for admission to Ph.D., requirement of NET qualification must be made be made mandatory. VC added that NET qualification is not mandatory for employment in industry. Hence a student seeking Ph.D. for the purpose of employment in industry will be unduly burdened. PVC was of the view that, for the time being, status quo may be maintained and any change may be considered later on. The members agreed to this view.

On the point of increase in intake it was pointed out that since we are not able to get good numbers, it is better that we become realistic in our approach as there is no point in increasing the intake disproportionately as it would also require recruitment of faculty proportionately and creating infrastructure without any optional utilization of the same. It was added that requirement shown in the agenda is a projection for future and actual enrollment will be done only when the requisite infrastructure is in place. As all such projection are required to be sent to the Government long before they are actually implemented, it will be prudent to seek approval of Academic Council in advance. The Government will be approached at an appropriate time. However, the members were of the view that a committee be formed and the recommendations of the committee be put up to the Council in its next meeting.

AC 5.3: To recommend to the BOM introduction of the new Courses wef session 2013-14 and to approve course curricula and syllabi.

A list of courses was presented to the Council along with syllabi for recommending the same to the Board of Management. Hence it is advisable to have some new but advance courses.

Following courses were suggested by different institutions:

- (a) M.Tech (Mechanical Engg with Mechatronics)
- (b) M.Tech (Mechanical Engg with Nuclear Engg)
- (c) M. Tech (Hydro systems Engg & Management)
- (d) 5 yrs integrated program in Maths and Computing
- (e) 5 yrs M.Sc (Economics)
- (f) 5 yrs M.Sc (Statistics)



- (g) M.Sc Graphics & Animation
- (h) M.Sc (Med Lab Technology)

The Pro Vice Chancellor proposed to form a committee under the Chairmanship of Dr. SK Dubey to finally suggest new programs incorporating brief outline and syllabi, including the above, for submission to the Academic Council. The members agreed to the same.

AC 5.4: To recommend to the Board of Management for starting of new Institute.

The Council was presented with a proposal to start following new Institute Schools

- (a) Amity School of Hotel Management
- (b) Amity Institute of Nano Sciences
- (c)Amity Institute of Laser Technology & Optoelectronics
- (d) Amity College of Commerce
- (e) Amity School of Economics

It was suggested to have a Center for Advance Technology which will include advance technology programs like Nano Sciences and Laser Technology. Dr. Dudeja pointed out that there may be problem of less enrolment in these Institutes. PVC suggested that to overcome the problem of less enrolment, these Institute may start Ph.D. program. Prof BP Singh added that to attract more students, fellowships also can be started. Dr. Dube opined that some policy may be devised to define the Department / School / Institute / Center etc.

# AC 5.5: To Review Admission plan for the session 2013-14 and progress made till date.

Admission in Charge, Dr. V Madhukar, presented a brief report on admission plan for the session 2013 and the progress made so far. He informed the Council that admission target for the session is 2500. The Council resolved to accept the report.

# AC 5.6: To recommend to the Board of management the number of teachers to be appointed.

Based on the probable enrolment, all the School / Institute have submitted requirement of teachers to be appointed in the forth coming session. The requirement was deliberated by

the members and it was decided to rationalize the requirement further. It was also recommended that experts from industry to be represented on faculty recruitment panels.

# AC 5.7: To recommend to the Board of Management name of students for the award of degree.

The Council resolved to recommend the list to the Board of Management. The Chairman, however, requested the Registrar to once more ensure that the list is correct in all respect.

# Ac 5.8: To recommend to the Board of Management introduction of Flexi Credit System.

Members deliberated the issue. It was brought out that large numbers of students are likely to register in easy popular courses, such as Photography. PVC was of the view that a cap on maximum number of students registering in a particular course be applied to avoid such situation. PVC also requested the HOD / Coordinators present in the council to seek cooperation from the faculty members as implementation of this new system would warrant a concerted and coordination effort. The council resolved to accept the recommendation made in the paper.

#### Ac 5.9: To amend marks distribution in B. Plan

Director, ASAP explained that ITPI criteria for weight distribution between theory and & practical paper is 50% each. Whereas at Amity we following a criteria 70% and 30%. As we are required to follow the norms of ITPI, the council resolves to accept the proposal.

### AC 5.10: Any other point with permission from the Chair.

The Member Secretary tabled the various Policies, SOPs and Guidelines shared as an Appx which needs to be introduced in r/o AUH and same needs to be vetted before they are put up to Board of Management and Governing Body for ratification. The council accepted the same.

With due permission from the Chairman, Air Cmde (Retd) K Thakur sought the approval of the council to revised syllabi of Aerospace Engineering that he proposed. He informed the council that the in revised syllabi many new subjects have been include while some old subjects which were obsolete have been discarded. In this process total credits have also been reduced to 202 from the earlier 230. A brief presentation on biomedical program was also made by Ms. Ipshita Gupta,



Dr. Dube suggested that courses on M. Tech in Medical Science and Technology can be started. This is a specialized course for MBBS qualified doctors. It does not require approval from any regulatory body. He also suggested that a course on Master of City Planning may be started. Prof S K Gupta replied that we already have the course namely M. Plan.

While closing up the meeting, the Vice Chancellor advised that if any new program is proposed by any Institute / School, the HOI/HOS concerned must inform the Registrar's office at least 5 months in advance as the Dept of Higher Education, Govt of Haryana is to be approached for this purpose at least 4 months in advance.

The meeting was then declare over after exchange of thanks between the Chair and members.


