#### **General Introduction of the Event:**

## Mental Health Awareness Programme, 11th August, 2023

Amity Institute of Clinical Psychology (AICP), Amity University Haryana, Gurgaon in collaboration with Civil Hospital organized one day Mental Health Awareness programme on 11<sup>th</sup> August, 2023 at Poly Clinic, sector 31 Gurugram. Dr. Mehfooz Ahmed, Ms Shirley Raj, Ms Aarti Shukla, Mr Sachin, M. Phil Clinical Psychology trainees, PDCP trainees and patients participated in the program. Dr. Mehfooz Ahmed was the coordinator of the program. The basic concepts of stress, depression and schizophrenia were discussed. The trainees performed two skits based upon alcohol addiction and Panic Disorder. The participants were insisted to disseminate acquired information in the community they belong to.
