General Introduction of the Event:

Mental Health Awareness Programme, 11th August, 2023

He emphasized that the nation's resources had been over exploited and depleted, it is necessary to develop environmental friendly surrounding in our endeavor to build a country of our dreams. He further emphasized that the sacrifices of our forebears must be remembered by our youth while forging ahead on a path of economic prosperity of our nation.

Maj Gen G. S. Bal gave a detailed account of the Horrors of Partition. He stated that the partition was based on a Two Nation Theory. How the people suffered due to partition was elaborately covered in his speech . He also informed the audience that the Hon'ble PM had declared in 2020, that 14 August each year will be recognized as the day of remembrance of the 1947 partition. The DSW requested the audience to observe a one minute silence to pay tributes to our freedom fighters and martyrs of the various conflicts, pre and post-independence.

3.1 General Introduction of the Event Earth Day, 23rd April, 2024

Amity Institute of Clinical Psychology (AICP), Amity University Haryana, Gurgaon organized Earth Day-2024 at Earth Saviour Foundation, Bandhwari Village, Gurugram. Dr. MN Kirmani, Dr. Mehfooz Ahmad, Ms Aarti, Mr Shashvat, (faculties of AICP) and M. Phil Clinical Psychology trainees, PDCP Students and PGDRP participated in the workshop.
