The University aims to recruit and admit students who demonstrate the highest potential to benefit from the University's academic environment, regardless of their background. The University's education aims to uplift these students' social and economic status, providing them with equal opportunities for employment and future growth.


Scholarships and Financial Assistance

The University offers Merit Scholarships and Means-Cum-Merit Scholarships to students and also provides financial assistance in accessing bank loans. In the academic year 2022-23, a total of 25000 students pursued their career at AUH with scholarships.

In an effort to support the financial needs of its students, Amity University has established partnerships with Oriental Bank of Commerce and Allahabad Bank. These partnerships provide various benefits to AUH students, including:








ENTREPRENEURSHIP DEVELOPMENT AND SKILL DEVELOPMENT

Amity University Haryana has been selected as a Partnering Institution under Unnat Bharat Abhiyan, a flagship project funded by the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India. This initiative aims to conduct development activities in five selected villages in Haryana.

AUH has conducted village and household surveys to assess the socioeconomic conditions of the villagers. Based on these surveys, AUH has organized various training and awareness camps in the fields of renewable energy, mental and physical health, nutrition, and entrepreneurship.

The Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship has recognized AUH as a training partner under the PM YUVA Yojana to educate and empower young aspiring entrepreneurs. The University aims to train 2,500 entrepreneurs over the next five years through a flexible, 18-credit certification course with six specialized tracks. Entrepreneurship development is also integrated into various programs to foster an entrepreneurial mindset.
