The Sustainable Food Policy serves as a framework to make sure that food and drinks are produced, sourced, consumed, and disposed off in a way that takes environmental protection, societal benefit, and animal welfare into account. Amity University Haryana is dedicated to offering the university community wholesome cuisine that is flavourful, nutritiously balanced, sustainable, and reasonably priced. As a provider of higher education, AUH has a significant part to play in addressing global concerns in all operations. AUH supports the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development and beyond through business operations, academic endeavours, and research.

This is incorporated in product sourcing and offering, managing catering operations. AUH strives to create positive environmental impacts and reduce negative ones through policy commitments.

The University will take into account a wide range of environmental and social impacts when sourcing and developing the products. These impacts include but are not limited to, greenhouse gas emissions and carbon footprint; water footprint; water and soil health; animal and plant health; food loss and waste; biodiversity; nutrition and health; workers' rights and safety; and animal welfare.

The policy pertains to everyone associated with the University community including students, employees, contracted service employees, vendors and visitors.

Communication: The policy is published widely through various University outlets and will be included in the *Student Handbook* and *website*. Existing policies, regulations, and penalties governing sustainable food inside university property will remain in effect as promulgated.

Compliance:

- 1. Amity University Haryana's hospitality meals and drinks are all covered by the sustainable food policy.
- 2. The Sustainable Food Policy and the Food Made Good Sustainable Food Framework, if applicable, contain commitments that university food vendors must follow.
- 3. The Policy must be adhered to by all employees and students participating in University activities.
- 4. The catering department at Amity University Haryana will aim to preserve and enhance its selection of food and beverages.

5. Annual reviews of action-related progress will be conducted, and results will be shared with the authorities of the University. The Annual SDG reports will include highlights.
