Anganwadi Adoption Project of NSS AUMP

As per the directives from the **Madhya Pradesh Private University Regulatory Commission (MPPURC) vide circular no. [1736/IT/MPPURC] dated 13/07/2023 and MP Govt Higher Education commission letter No [538/194/NSS/2022/38] dated 11.07.2023**, it was mandated to adopt one Anganwadi Kendra by NSS unit of Amity University Madhya Pradesh (AUMP). Anganwadi kendra of the NSS adopted village Chakraipur is duly functional and was selected for adoption. Due permissions were obtained from the office of the Child Development Project Officer (CDPO) Morar, WCD (Women and Child Development Department), Distt- Gwalior.

Anganwadi Kendra of village Chakraipur is presently functional in the village community center. Approximately 45 children of age 0-5 year come to the Anganwadi on working days. The Anganwadi is functional with one Anganwadi worker and one helper. To initiate the project, inspection of circumstances and working conditions prevailing in the Anganwadi premises and the surroundings revealed the requirements to enhance the facilities available for the children of Anganwadi and also the capacity building of the caretakers of the Anganwadi. Whitewashing and repairing work planned for the Anganwadi adoption project has been accomplished. Books, Copies, color pencils and useful stationery to enhance the cognitive skills of the students of the Anganwadi children along with stationery useful for capacity building of the Anganwadi workers were gifted to the Anganwadi on 3.11.2023. Charts and posters for diversifying their general knowledge and mathematical skills were also gifted. A beautiful function was organized by the NSS unit of AUMP in the Anganwadi Kendra on 18th November 2023. Honorable Pro chancellor of Amity University Madhya Pradesh visited the Anganwadi and gifted toys, chairs, study tables and furniture to the Anganwadi children for increasing their comfort and interest to come to the Anganwadi. To teach them the importance of domestic waste management, separate waste bins were gifted to them. Height Chart and weighing machine were provided for periodic health monitoring of the children. NSS volunteers of AUMP interact with the Anganwadi children to teach them one specific topic regarding hygiene, healthcare, nutrition, good conduct, good touch

and bad touch. It is a very sweet initiative of the Govt. for it bonds Amity University NSS volunteers with children of Anganwadi.

Committee was formed with responsible youngsters from the village and the NSS volunteers of AUMP for safe and regular use of the toys, stationery and furniture in the adopted Anganwadi. Stock registers have been prepared with instructions to maintain the stocks regularly. The youth of the village enthusiastically participated in the celebrations of the and Anganwadi adoption. Regular maintenance of Anganwadi has been taken up by Amity University Madhya Pradesh and there are future plans to build boundary wall and further development.
