The concerned executives of JBM and corresponding faculty members of AUMP together will update/ modify syllabi for academic programs, new courses, joint research projects and training for skill oriented Human Resources with due approval and within the framework of rules and regulations governing both the organizations.

VIRTUAL CENTER FOR INTERDISCIPLINARY RESEARCH

The centre will strive to provide maximum benefit to student community and JBM staff in terms of:

- Suggesting syllabus up-gradation/ modifications to meet current requirement of Industry.
- Project/Research platform to U.G., P.G. and Ph.D. scholars.
- Expert lectures by JBM Executives for AUMP students.
- Skill oriented training and vocational course for JBM staff.
- Technology development and demonstration.

PROJECT WORK OF STUDENTS

A total of about 5 to 7 selected students of U.G., P.G. and Ph.D. in the respective areas of specialization of AUMP will be allowed at a time for project work at JBM. Students will work in mutually agreeable areas identified by both the organizations.
