

**A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING ON “ACADEMIC

**AMITY UNIVERSITY MADHYA PRADESH, GWALIOR** was established by **Ritnand Balved Education Foundation (RBEF)** vide Madhya Pradesh Government Legislature Act of 2010 with the view to promote professional, industry-oriented education in the state of Madhya Pradesh. Amity University Madhya Pradesh, Gwalior which is located on a sprawling campus of 102 acres of land opposite Gwalior Airport, imparts modern, practical and research-oriented courses that will lead to the development of professionals who are employable and industry ready. This in turn will drive the socio-economic uplift of the region. Amity imparts education in almost all areas including management, engineering, architecture, biotechnology, law, communication, behavioral science, fine arts, fashion etc.

CFCS provides the industrial solution with the proper combination of Hardware and Software. Presently, the dynamics of study programmes demand, combined with our/ their institutional capabilities, lead to Bachelor study programmes, Master study programmes and PhD study programmes.

In the interest of establishing a relationship of mutual benefit to both the organizations, **Amity University, Madhya Pradesh (AUMP)** and **CFCS, GURUGRAM** have agreed to the specific areas of collaboration on academic and research related activities as mentioned in this MoU.

## 1. Objectives:

- 1.1. To contribute further to the regional understanding between faculty and staff of **AUMP** and **CFCS, GURUGRAM** for enhancing skills of students/aspirants through internships and vocational trainings, in order to enhance the quality of Technical and Engineering education in the Country.
- 1.2. To strengthen collaboration between **CFCS, GURUGRAM** and **AUMP** through academic programs in instruction, research and faculty development among the faculty and students of both parties.

## 2. Scope

The Scope of collaboration on academic and research activities in this Memorandum of Understanding includes the following categories:

1. To develop research projects jointly and avail funding
2. Exchange of academic information, materials and facilities
3. Student Exchange
4. Faculty and Staff Exchange
5. Research aid to Ph.D. scholars by both parties
6. Intellectual property rights of the collaboration work belonging to both parties
7. Organization/ participation in Joint symposia, seminars, conferences, workshops etc.
8. Developing articulations for twinning/joint programs and allowing students to undertake part in the programme / course of study at each organization
9. Promoting other such activities/programs as mutually agreed from time to time

### 2.1 To develop research projects jointly and avail funding

Both the parties agree to undertake research projects/activities through sharing of research ideas, data and academic resources that can lead to joint publications, development of any product or other intended outcomes like Intellectual property rights/ patents/discoveries




generated out of the research activities, belonging to both parties. Such collaboration activities will also include joint research conferences, visitations and sabbaticals at each other's premises; subject to mutual consent of both the parties. All such joint research activities will be governed by the terms and conditions laid down by separate written agreement between the two organizations.

## **2.2 Exchange of academic information, materials and facilities**

Both parties agree to exchange academic information, facilities, resources etc. as mutually agreed from time to time.

## **2.3 Students Exchange**

### **2.3.1 Student Exchange Programs**

Both the parties agree to develop programs whereby the students of either organization can have the opportunity to study at the other organization with mutual recognition of the credit hours arising there from. It is desired by both organizations that there will be significant flow of students in exchange as reciprocal. Both parties agree to facilitate internship facilities for exchange students as mutually agreed. Pursuant to the specific agreement for academic exchange, **CFCS, GURUGRAM** and **Amity University** will exchange students according to the terms and conditions laid out by separate written agreement by both organizations.

### **2.3.2 Short Courses/ Summer School**

These courses, usually two to four weeks in duration, will normally be held in spring or summer as mutually agreed. The programs will facilitate visits by students and faculty to learn about the industry environment and culture. In addition to various topics on industry operations and culture, the course would include meetings with industry executives, and visits to various industrial establishments. The cost and other terms of such programs will be mutually worked out separately each year.

## **2.4 Faculty and Staff Exchange**

Both organizations agree to develop opportunities for faculty to teach courses, conduct seminars and undertake such other activities at each other's campus as mutually agreed. Visiting faculty will be provided with opportunities to observe and share teaching methods and curriculum. **CFCS, GURUGRAM** and **Amity University** will exchange faculty according to the terms and conditions as mutually agreed upon.

## **2.5 Organization/ participation in Joint symposia, seminars, conferences, workshops etc.**

Both organizations will promote their faculty and staff participation in the conferences, conclaves and seminars organized by each other to strengthen the ties between both the organizations and will also jointly organize symposia, seminars, conferences, workshops and other programs as mutually agreed.

## **3. Advertising & Publicity**

Both the parties will publicly advertise the collaboration under this MoU among students, staff etc., if agreed by their management. Where reasonably possible, in making advertisements or public announcements in relation to this MoU, each organization shall acknowledge the participation of other organization and the contribution that other organization has made, if any.




#### 4. Commencement, renewal, termination and amendment

This MOU will come into force upon affixing of the signatures of the representatives of the both organizations and will remain in effect for three (3) years. This MOU will be renewed upon its expiry, as per mutual agreement of both organizations. If either organization wishes to terminate the MOU at the end of the three years' period or in between the period of three years, it must notify the other organization not less than six months prior to the expiry of the MOU. The event of termination will not affect participants from completing their activities at the host party already initiated or ongoing unless otherwise mutually agreed. This MoU, its renewal and the actions taken under it will be reviewed at any time. Modifications to MoU will be made by mutual consent and any amendment or extension to the MoU will be formalized by the exchange of letters and/ or emails between the two organizations.

#### 5. Coordinators:

Each organization agrees to appoint an overall Coordinator for the administration of this MOU. The Coordinator will serve as the contact person on campus. These coordinators will ensure smooth flow of communication and would be responsible to ensure that necessary approvals are in place for student/faculty exchange, articulation agreement etc. These coordinators will be responsible to ensure the effectiveness and enforcement of MOU. Both organizations are responsible for keeping their contact details up to date. Contact details and address of the designated coordinators are given hereunder:
