Cleanliness Awareness Campaign in the NSS adopted villages Chakraipur

NSS volunteers of AUMP conducted cleanliness awareness campaign in the NSS adopted villages Chakraipur. Awareness campaign was organized on 4th November 2023 in the NSS adopted villages Chakraipur to educate the villagers about healthier ways of living and better management of surrounding environment. It enhances the productivity of all individuals if clean environments and ecofriendly modes of living are adopted. The villagers also responded to these efforts of volunteers and promised to remain vigilant for maximum refuse, reuse, recycle, reduce, recover and repurpose the plastics, metals as the 6R fundamental for ecofriendly lifestyles. They promised to support the efforts of the government for making Chakraipur a total open defecation free village. The volunteers started the campaign at 0930 hrs and concluded the program at 1430 hrs. 40 NSS volunteers of AUMP visited the adopted village Chakraipur for cleanliness campaign.
