Preface

Department of Applied Mathematics, Amity School of Engineering & Technology, Amity University Madhya Pradesh organized an expert talk on the topic “**Fascinating World of Mathematics**” for the celebration of **National Mathematics Day** on 21nd Dec., 2023. The talk was arranged in Seminar Hall (A-Block) for B. Tech. students. On Dec. 22nd, the birthday of great Indian Mathematician Srinivasa Ramanujan is celebrated each year. In the honour of Ramanujan, in the year 2012, Indian government declared 22nd Dec. as National Mathematics Day. Therefore, it is a tradition to celebrate National Mathematics Day by the Department of Applied Mathematics, ASET, AUMP each year.

Registrations and Participants

The program was arranged for in house B. Tech. (I Sem.) students. The number of students who registered and participated was 200 approx.

Sessions of the lecture series: 2:30 pm-4:00 pm

The moderator of the session was Dr. Rajat Vaish, Assistant Professor, Department of Applied Mathematics. He initiated the session by extending formal welcome to all the participants, and Prof. Kuldeep Dwivedi, Dean Academics, AUMP followed by the introduction of the expert Prof. Joydeep Dhar, AVB-IIITM, Gwalior.



Opening Remark of the session was delivered by the Prof. Kuldeep Dwivedi, Dean Academics, AUMP. Dr. Dwivedi delivered the information about the importance of Mathematics in daily life and talked about the contribution of Ramanujan to Mathematics community.



Later, Prof. Dhar told that without any formal training of mathematics Srinivasa Ramanujan created several concepts and theorems of mathematics. By the age of 12 he mastered the advanced trigonometry book by S. L. Loney and at the age of 16 he studied the book A synopsis of elementary results in pure and applied mathematics (containing 5000 theorems) written by G. S. Karr. In 1913, he started working with G. H. Hardy and J. E. Littlewood great English mathematicians. Then, he went to England and worked with G.H. Hardy for some time. But, due to his illness he returned India in 1919 and died on 26th April, 1920. During his very short span of life, he contributed 3900 results on Mathematics. Further, Prof. Dhar explained several applications of Mathematics in real world scenarios. By the talk, the students got glimpses of the beauty of Mathematics made by Ramanujan.



During the program, all the students of B. Tech. (I Sem) have been participated enthusiastically. They made several question from the speakers after each delivery of the lecture. The program was concluded by the vote of thanks by Dr. Santosh Kumar Sharma, Head Department of Applied Mathematics, ASET, AUMP.

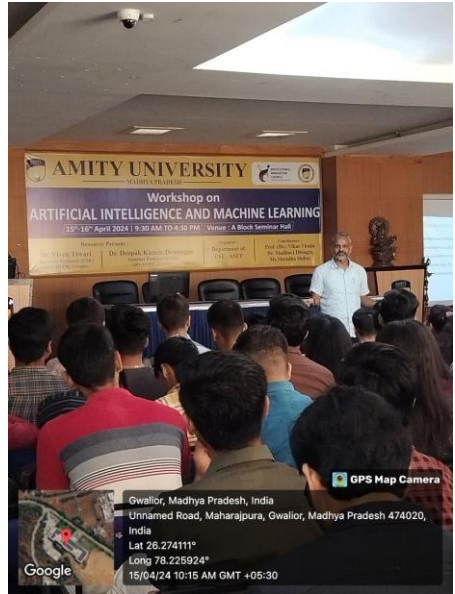

डॉ. रस्तोगी ने स्टेमी का इलाज पर विस्तार से जानकारी साझा की। उन्होंने बताया कि स्टेमी एक चिकित्सा आपात स्थिति है। यदि आपको स्टेमी का संदेह है, तो तुरंत चिकित्सीय सहायता लेनी चाहिए। जितनी जल्दी इलाज शुरू किया जाता है, उतना ही कम हृदय की क्षति होती है और मृत्यु का खतरा कम होता है। स्टेमी के उपचार में आमतौर पर अवरुद्ध धमनी को खोलने के लिए एंजियोप्लास्टी या बाईपास सर्जरी

और रक्त के थक्कों को रोकने के लिए दवाएं। हृदय को मजबूत करने और भविष्य के दिल के दौरों के जोखिम को कम करने के लिए दवाएं।

Workshop on Rotary Vacuum Evaporator (Buchi, India Pvt Ltd)

Amity Institute of Pharmacy, AUMP organized a “Workshop on Rotary Vacuum Evaporator (Buchi, India Pvt Ltd)” on 09th May 2024 from 02:30 to 05:00 pm. The training was initiated by **Mr. Naresh Singh, Senior Service Engineer**, Buchi India Pvt. Ltd. He gave the overview of the Rotary Evaporator (R-300 generation) by showing various components including chiller machine, heating bath, condensed solvent collector, condenser, vacuum pump, temperature cum rotation controller, and waste vessel. He has also shown the digital interface of the rotary evaporator to get the information on vacuum settings in terms of (m bar). Mr. Singh demonstrated the different operations, such as setting the vacuum, fixing the sample solvent vessel, and setting the temperature cum Rotation to participants. He has detailed the rotary evaporation, which works on the principle of reduced pressure, thin film formation of solvent across the glass flask using rotation and applying elevated temperature. Moreover, he also discussed troubleshooting the common rotary evaporator issues and basic preventative measures.

The faculty members and non-teaching of Amity Institute of Pharmacy have participated in the workshop enthusiastically. The workshop was attended by 22 faculty members, 07 non-teaching staff and B. Pharm students. The session provides a comprehensive understanding of the distillation under reduced pressure using different parameters such as Rotation per minute, elevated boiling points, and condensation of evaporated solvent, including a hands-on session on how to set up, operate, and clean a rotary evaporator. The program was organized by **Dr. V. Murugesan, Professor, Department of Pharmaceutical Chemistry**. This program was successfully planned, and organized with the co-ordination of **Prof. S. Mohana Lakshmi, Director, AIP, AUMP**.

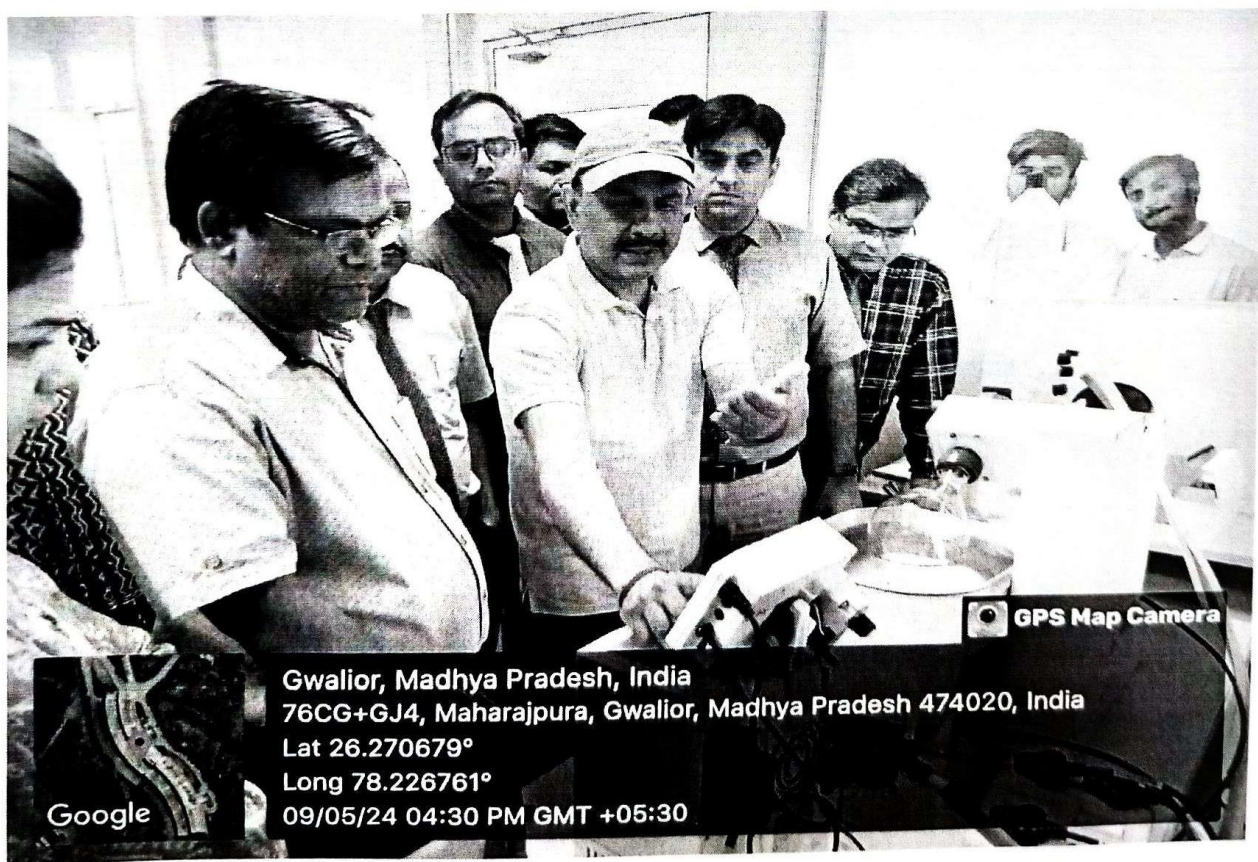
