E-Governance in Admissions Department

- In AUMP, from 2017 to 2018, the Admissions process was in hybrid mode. In this
 mode, Admissions Form was available in online and off line mode both and the
 entrance test process was also off line.
- In 2019, The E-Governance was semi-functional in admissions department of AUMP because the admission entrance test was in offline mode.
- In 2020 and 2021, AUMP had implemented the E-Governance fully in admissions process from Online Admissions Form till the withdrawal of admissions.
- In 2023-24, AUMP had e-governance fully functional from lead generation, form filling to final fee deposition of first semester.






Call Centre Operation:

Amity University, Gwalior application process is available in online as well as offline mode. Students can fill the application form in the desired mode along with the application. Students have the flexibility to pay the application fee online through a debit/credit card or offline through a demand draft.



The steps to submit the application form in the offline mode are mentioned below:


Step 1: Visit the official website of Amity University and click on 'Apply Now 2023'.

Step 3: You will be redirected to a new page where your ID and password will be given. you must save this to login in the future. The option to download the form is also provided on this page. Click it to save the form in offline mode. You need to completely fill out this form and send it to the Amity University office.

Step 4 : Select the programme, Campus that you want to study. You need to enter personal details like your date of birth, category, if you need hostel accommodation and enter your address. Click on 'Save and Next'.








- Online Test on Google Docs: Test Marks will be updated at Amizone.
- 2. Online Interview: Interview marks will be updated at Amizone.






Online Payment by Student thru microsite:

Scholarship



The Scholarship approval process is fully online.

- 1. Director Admission verifies the online documents at Admission Intranet/Amizone. (Marksheet of Class 10th and 12th)
- 2. As per policy of AUMP the scholarship is allotted by Director Admission at Admission Intranet/ Amizone.
- 3. Admissions Director issues/publish the online offer letter of Admission with scholarship to eligible candidate.
- 4. After allocation of Scholarship by Director Admissions, The scholarship gets reflected under the Admissions Intranet/Amizone of Account department.



1. Director Admission verifies the online documents at Admission Intranet/Amizone. (Marksheet of Class 10th and 12th)











2. As per policy of AUMP the scholarship is allotted by Director Admission at Admission Intranet/ Amizone.

Online Admission Withdrawal Process



The withdrawal process is fully online. Student needs to follow below steps.

- 1. Mark withdrawal at microsite/ Amizone under his ID.
- 2. HOI will approve withdrawal at Amizone.
- 3. No Dues will be done by library, hostel, admin office, IT.
- 4. Admissions Director will approve withdrawal.
- 5. Account will approve withdrawal and send to HO for final payment.
- 6. Payment will be transferred to account of student.
