Preface

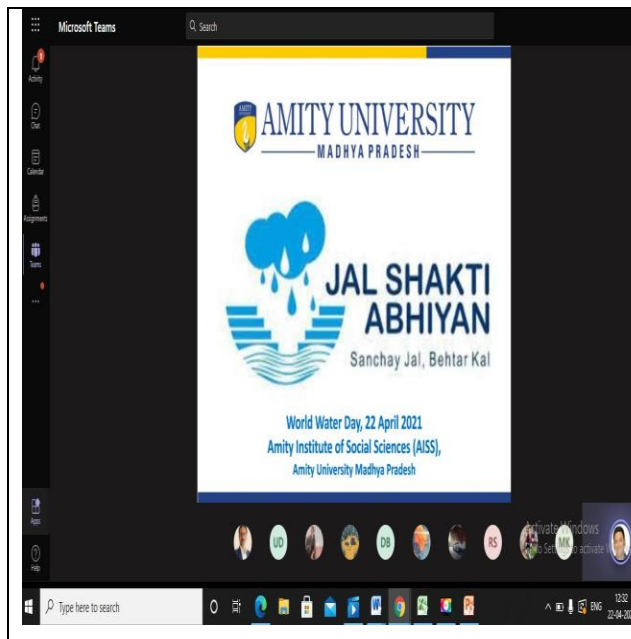

Participation

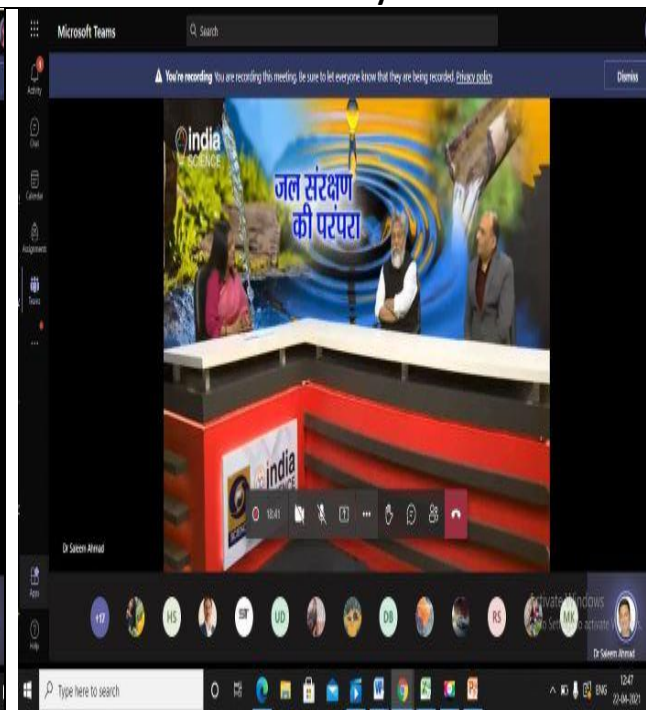
Ten NSS Volunteers from AISS and about 200 students participated in the activity.

Free Blood Glucose Test Camp at AUMP Campus

National Service Scheme Unit of Amity University organized 'Free Blood Glucose Monitoring Facility' Camp for the faculty, staff and faculty members of the University on 4/5/2022 in the Foyer of Block A, AUMP Campus.

Chairman, NSS, AUMP, Major General Dr. SC Jain, VSM** (Retd.), informed that Amity University, under the guidance of Vice Chancellor, Amity Lt Gen VK Sharma, AVSM, (Retd.) has been working hard for its high teaching quality and good health of the staff. This special program was organized to fulfill the objective of continuous discharge of moral responsibility towards all staff associated with AUMP.

During the camp, fasting blood sugar, post-prandial blood sugar and random blood sugar were tested free of cost. The beneficiaries with disordered blood sugar were provided with necessary advice and information.

43 NSS volunteers coordinated the event for free checkup of blood glucose in the AUMP campus. Mess workers, sanitation workers and security guards and other staff also took advantage of the 'Free Blood Glucose Monitoring Facility' in this camp.
