Institutions may provide housing directly, such as building and maintaining student residences on or near campus. Additionally, financial support in the form of housing grants, subsidies, or scholarships can help students afford accommodation. This also reduces students' reliance on longer commutes, improving their focus on academic pursuits and their overall well-being. Collaborating with local housing authorities or private developers to create affordable housing options is another pathway institutions can take to enhance student living conditions.
