Sustainability Literacy Assessment Tool for Staff

Yes, Amity University Rajasthan has a strong way to test all its staff, both academic and professional, on their knowledge and understanding of sustainability. This 25-question multiple-choice quiz was created following our in-depth sustainability training program. The purpose of this MCQ was to assess basic knowledge of environmental principles, social equity, and economic viability, governance as well as real-world applications like the SDGs, ESG frameworks, the circular economy, and carbon accounting etc. There were four options for each question, and check boxes make it easy to manage on paper or digitally.

In Amity University Rajasthan, all staffs do it once a year or after training, and the score are automatically calculated to track progress and find areas that need improvement. For example, the questions cover the triple bottom line, the goals of the Paris Agreement, the waste hierarchy, and net-zero strategies. This makes sure that they are in line with global standards like the UN SDGs. In 2025, 150 staff members took part in pilot testing and got an average score of 85%. This led to targeted interventions like workshops. This tool helps create a culture of sustainability accountability, helps us reach our goal of net-zero by 2050, and works with our institutional KPIs.
