6. Registration Process

How to Register and Registration fees:

- Participation Fee: ₹200 per participant.
- Registration Steps:
 - 1. Register on the official website.
 - 2. DM us at asco_lucknow on Instagram with a screenshot of your registration.
 - 3. Submit your performance video via Instagram DM.

7. Competition Format

How the Competition Will Be Conducted:

- Preliminary Round (Online):
 - Participants must submit a 1-minute monologue followed by a 1-minute dance performance via video.
 - Videos will be judged by a panel, and shortlisted performances will be featured on Instagram.

• Final Round (Offline):

- Shortlisted participants will perform their submitted monologue and dance routine live (1-minute monologue followed by a 2-minute dance performance).
- Final performances must match the content submitted during the preliminary round.

8. Judging Criteria

Key Evaluation Parameters:

- Clarity of monologue, voice quality, and pronunciation.
- Precision of dance moves, posture, confidence, and alignment with the beat and mood of the music.
- Emotional connection with the audience through expressions.
- Confidence and energy throughout the performance.
- Costume and makeup.

Note: The judges' decisions will be final and binding.

9. Prizes & Awards

Prizes and Recognitions for Winners:

- Winner: ₹5000
- First Runner-Up: ₹1500
- Second Runner-Up: ₹1500
- All participants will receive certificates of participation.

10. Rules & Regulations

Participation Guidelines and Restrictions:

- Participants must adhere to time limits and submit their entries in proper costumes, basic makeup, and with props if required.
- Only one entry per participant is allowed, and videos must be of good visual quality.
- The medium of language is Hindi or English.
- Offensive content or language violating religion or privacy will lead to immediate disqualification.
